- <u>Large Building Water Quality Issues</u> Recognize water quality challenges of premise plumbing systems in large buildings; discuss the difference between water supplier and building owner responsibilities; and identify actions to take from the water supply side to help mitigate or prevent water quality issues
- <u>PFAS Contaminant of Concern</u> Attendees will achieve greater knowledge of PFAS/PFOA and associated health concerns; understand current regulations; identify proper sampling procedures; understand how to address the problem, and identify resources for assistance
- <u>Controlling Lead in Drinking Water</u> *Topics covered in the workshop include the regulations;* corrosion basics; conducting an inventory; monitoring requirements; treatment requirements; public notification requirements; and lead service line replacement.
