## The Workshop will cover the following topics:

- **AWIA Small Systems Resilience** — *This topic provides a refresh of the AWIA Deadlines and Requirements; introduces AWWA/RCAP Risk & Resiliency Resources for RRAs and ERPs; and equips small systems to be resilient to all hazards*
- **Regulatory Overview** — *Topics covered include history of public health protection, distribution system health impacts, revised total coliform rule, ground water rule, stage 2 DBP rule, and LCR*
- **Large Building Water Quality Issues** - *Recognize water quality challenges of premise plumbing systems in large buildings; discuss the difference between water supplier and building owner responsibilities; and identify actions to take from the water supply side to help mitigate or prevent water quality issues*
- **PFAS – Contaminant of Concern** — *Attendees will achieve greater knowledge of PFAS/PFOA and associated health concerns; understand current regulations; identify proper sampling procedures; understand how to address the problem, and identify resources for assistance*
- **Controlling Lead in Drinking Water** - *Topics covered in the workshop include the regulations; corrosion basics; conducting an inventory; monitoring requirements; treatment requirements; public notification requirements; and lead service line replacement.*
