

Pie Crust and Pâte à Choux (Cream Puffs, Éclair) Pastry Clinic



Bring your pastry struggles and pie crust woes to Annunciation on November 19, from 12-2:30 pm, and get tips from Rev. Elizabeth on making and rolling a perfect (and foolproof - really!) pie crust, just in time for the holidays. We'll also learn about how to make pâte à choux pastry - the 'stuff' cream puffs and eclairs are made of. (Not a sweets person? Both these pastries can be used in savory applications, too.)

You'll leave with enough pie dough to make a two-crust pie, and a batch of pâte à choux dough to bake off at home. You'll be able to taste samples, as well. The cost is \$10/person to defray the ingredient costs; any excess funds will be given to the Annunciation PADS program to feed the homeless.
