





FIRST READING: Psalm 104:1-12 <sup>1</sup>Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, you are very great. You are clothed with honor and majesty, <sup>2</sup>wrapped in light as with a garment. You stretch out the heavens like a tent, <sup>3</sup>you set the beams of your chambers on the waters, you make the clouds your chariot, you ride on the wings of the wind, <sup>4</sup>you make the winds your messengers, fire and flame your ministers. <sup>5</sup>You set the earth on its foundations, so that it shall never be shaken. <sup>6</sup>You cover it with the deep as with a garment; the waters stood above the mountains. 

#### COMMUNION


The body of Christ, given for you. The blood of Christ, shed for you.




