DESCRIPTION: This is a collector's special. I haven't been able to find out anything about this Groves A-3 target recurve. It may have been a one-of-a-kind prototype, perhaps an early wooden prototype of the GS 300. Brazilian Rosewood and Maple riser. Factory installed bushings for a 1/4" plunger and a stabilizer. This grip is a high wrist type, but very comfortable to hold and shoot. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Groves signature tip overlays are in good condition. 2 filled screw holes on the side of the riser (see pic on p. 5). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is a reproduction. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed.). Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new (old stock 1/4" plunger), and new flipper rest, and a new AMO 69" Dacron 12 strand string.
