Gabe Clor, age 70, of Caseville died Tuesday, December 8, at his home of a probable heart attack.

He was born March 24, 1928 in Harbor Beach to the late Joseph and Clare (Messing) Clor.

After leaving the family farm near Forestville, Mr. Clor served in the Coast Guard on the Great Lakes. At one time he owned Gabe's Sinclair Service Station in Forestville. He worked for Marlette Mobile Homes from 1959 to 1964 and in 1971 retired from his job as a welder at Ranke, Inc. in Roseville where he had been employed since 1965. Mr. Clor moved from Sterling Heights to Caseville in 1937. He was a member of St. Roch Catholic Church in Caseville, and a member of the Caseville Eagles.
