3. Registration forms must be received no later than Wednesday, October 17 by 5 PM.
4. Pie must be dropped off at Wildwood Pavilion on Saturday, October 27 between 10:30 and 11 AM.
5. Pie that needs to be kept cold must be accompanied by an ice tray.
6. Each pie must be made from scratch, with an exception of the crust.
7. Each pie must be presented in a disposable container.
8. Pie must accompany an ingredient list on a 3" x 5" card with the recipe name.
9. All pies become property of HART Equine Therapy Center, Inc.; all pies will be sold for proceeds benefitting HART.
10. There is no entry fee to participate in this contest.
11. Enter as many pies as you wish.
12. The decision of the judges is final. Judge will not know participant names.
13. Winner will be announced at 2:30 PM, prizes to be announced.

Judging:

1. Overall appearance
2. Crust color, flavor, texture and doneness
3. Filling consistency, doneness, flavor
4. Originality
