Effective immediately, the State of Maine will no longer mail hard copy invoices for the following license prefix types: ADR,ADN,AGR,AGN,AFR,AFN,CON,CFR,CFN,ERN,ERR,EDR,EDN,MVR,MVN,NAV,SSD,SSF,STR,STN.

The invoices will now be emailed 90 days prior to the due date and sent to the primary email address on record with the State of Maine. If there is no email on file or the email is invalid, an invoice will then be mailed.

The licenses are emailed one day following licensure and sent to the primary email address on record with the State of Maine. If there is no email on file or the email is invalid, the license is then mailed.
