

# **LAURA J. LIVINGSTON**

## **1929 - 1993**

Laura J. Livingston, 63, retired USA School teacher, died Friday evening, Oct. 8, in St. Mary's Medical Center, Saginaw, from injuries received in an auto accident near Caro on the previous day.

She was born in Ellington Township, Tuscola County, on Dec. 2, 1929, daughter of Lawrence and Olive (Miller) Drake. Her father died before her birth and she was raised by Arthur and Olive Aiken.

She was married to Lewis C. Livingston on Aug. 4, 1958, in Caro and he survives her.

Mrs. Livingston had been an elementary school teacher for 34 years in many one-room schools in the area. In 1964 she began teaching in Unionville Elementary School until her retirement in 1988.

She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church, Sebawing, where she taught Sunday School for several years. She was a member of Michigan Education Association.

Surviving, besides her husband Lewis are three sons and spouses, David and Susan Livingston of White Lake, Terry and Merrina Livingston of Cotton, MN, and Gaylan Livingston of Anza, CA; five grandchildren; one great-granddaughter; two sisters, Doris Schwedener of Big Rapids and Ruth Aiken of Iverness, FL.; one stepsister, Ila Gross of St. Clair; one brother, Everett Aiken of East Jordan and several nieces and nephews.

One son, Dale A. Livingston, and one sister, Evelyn Drake, preceded her in death.

The funeral service took place at 2 p.m. Monday, Oct. 11, at Trinity Church. Rev. Lawrence Brooks officiated. Burial was in Almer Township Cemetery, Caro. Funeral arrangements were in charge of Dinkal-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawing.
