Questions About The Eligibility Process

Find the answers to your questions concerning eligibility below:

1. Do I have to be African American to apply? **Yes**
2. Is there a minimum GPA requirement? **Yes, see the application**
3. Do I have to be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident to apply for a scholarship? **Yes, see the instructions for the application**
4. If I am a refugee or have established asylum status, am I eligible to apply? **It depends, see the instructions for the application**
5. If I have an International Student Visa or a Work Visa, am I eligible to apply? **It depends, see the instructions for the application**
6. I am a high school student. When can I apply? **Check with your Denton ISD counselor on your campus for the application and timeline**
7. If I attend, or have attended, a high school or university in another country, am I eligible to apply? **It depends, see the instructions for the application**
8. I am older than the traditional college student. Am I eligible to apply? **No, The DAASF provides scholarships for current graduating high school seniors**
9. Do you offer scholarships for Community College Students? **This scholarship is for graduating high school seniors enrolled in Denton ISD**
10. I am enrolled part-time. Am I eligible to apply? **This scholarship is for graduating high school seniors enrolled in Denton ISD**
11. I am a home-schooled student. Am I eligible to apply? **This scholarship is for graduating high school seniors enrolled in Denton ISD**
