JUNE 2019/YEAR-END CULTURAL ARTS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Cultural Arts Committee began the 2018-19 school year by holding a workshop as part of the MCCPTA Fall Training event. We provided information for participants on how to hire performers for their school assemblies, workshops and artist-in-residency programs; how to advocate for increased budgets for cultural arts programming (giving the results of the annual Cultural Arts Budget Survey); free programs that are available, etc. A guest speaker at the workshop was Seda Gelenian, who is Chair of the Superintendent's Committee for Performances in MCPS, and is also the producer and coordinator of the Cultural Arts Showcases.

This year, due to conflicts that a number of the performers had, we held only two days and one evening of Cultural Arts Showcases, on October 2nd, 3rd, and 11th. At the Showcases, we distributed the 2018-19 MCPS Performing Arts Catalogue, as well as brochures from the performers, and pertinent information for all Cultural Arts Chairs. (Schools that did not send a rep to the showcases had a catalogue mailed to them.)

I also post any information I receive about grants or free performances, so it is IMPORTANT for every school to have one or more representatives on this e-list.
