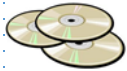

Communion Practices of this Congregation

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at St. John's every Sunday in the confession and glad confidence that, as he says, our Lord Jesus gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with him and with one another. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as he forgives and loves us, that they may show forth his death until he comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who hold a confession differing from that of this congregation and The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the Sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor or an elder. In addition to the members of this congregation, visitors from our sister LCMS congregations and other Lutheran denominations with whom we enjoy altar fellowship are invited to join us at the Lord's Table. Voters Meeting

Our Church Council has called a **special meeting of the Voters' Assembly for Sunday, June 20, immediately following worship**. The purpose of this meeting is to consider a proposal to enter into a long-term lease agreement with Family Promise of Greater Beloit (formerly Hands of Faith). This not-for-profit community organization works to prevent homelessness among Beloit residents and to provide shelter to those who are experiencing homelessness. You can learn more about them by going to their website: <https://www.familypromisebeloit.org/>. They are interested in entering into a ten-year lease agreement with us for the use of the three classrooms, kitchen, and locker rooms in the new school building ('82); and the three downstairs classrooms in the first school building ('51). Their intention is to establish a permanent facility that can shelter up to six families at any given time. The Midwest Tarheels Select Sports organization will continue to occupy the gym and the upstairs classrooms in the first school building ('51) on a month-to-month basis. Because of the length of the lease and the building modifications that will need to be undertaken (at Family Promise's expense), the Council is bringing this before the Voters for approval. If you have questions, please speak with Pastor or any of our Council members. We are excited about this opportunity to bless our community through the resources that God has placed into our care.
