**RED DOT PROGRAM LETS FIRST RESPONDERS QUICKLY ACCESS PATIENTS' MEDICAL HISTORY**

When 911 personnel respond to a medical emergency, they need to access a home quickly and get information on medical history. Allergies and emergency contacts.

That's why Charlotte County created the Red Dot program more than 10 years ago. Which allows first responders to easily access participants' information. There are currently between 1,500 and 1,800 participants. Said E911 Coordinator Laurie Anderson.

"If there's certain things they're allergic to that the paramedics would not want to be administered, or something the paramedics need to know right away. They would need to know it when they get on scene," Anderson said, "Any emergency contacts, gate codes, key codes to get access into the home during an emergency, emergency contacts—they fill all that stuff out."

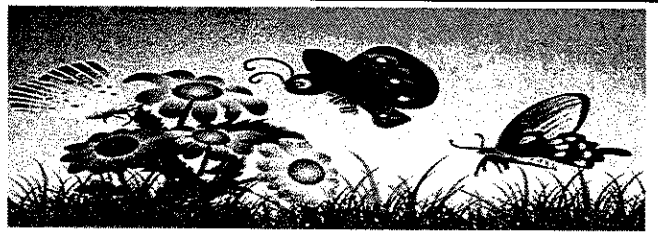
The program is paid for by the four area hospitals and is entirely free to participants. Anyone wishing to participate can pick up a Red Dot packet at all four Charlotte County Fire & EMS headquarters, the Punta Gorda Police Department, or area hospitals. The packet includes a brochure with directions, a carbon copy form, a Red Dot sticker, a return envelope. The top portion of the form is kept by the patient in the red magnetic holder to be kept on the refrigerator door, while the bottom part of the form is mailed to 911. E911 staff enter the information into the 911 computers. Where it's stored in the E911 database. In the event of an emergency, 911 dispatchers can provide the information to emergency responders while they are en route to patients' homes.

The Red Dot sticker, along with the dispatcher's notes, alerts emergency responders that there is a Red Dot Medical Information Form on the patient's refrigerator.

"If this person can't speak or communicate effectively, depending on the situation, they can grab that paper, and it can tell them all the major medical information about this person,"

Anderson said. If a patient requires hospital care, the Red Dot information is transported to the hospital as well and copies are provided to emergency room staff.

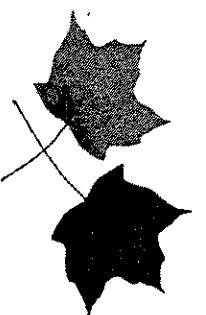
