1. The winner will be required to attend the following events:

3. 2 Speaking/Presentation Events (combined with other community events):
 - This should include visiting schools, 4-H clubs, nursing homes, FFA, and other community organizations to promote the Fair and the Fairest of the Fair event.
4. Attend a Fair Board Meeting
 - Attend Meetings as you are able to keep up to date on what plans are being made for the fair.
 - Reflect on your past year as Fairest of the Fair, update the board on potential candidates for the 2027 county position,
5. Attend the State Fairest of the Fair Contest
 - Early January at Chula Vista Resort in Wisconsin Dells, as Fairest, you are expected to represent Marquette County.
6. Attend the 2027 Fairest of the Fair Interviews and Coronation

7. Dress and present yourself in a professional manner at all times when performing Fairest of the Fair Duties. Dress in business or professional attire, accompanied by the sash and crown, as well as act in a business professional manner while on duty promoting and representing the Marquette County Fair. Dresses should be knee length, no plunging necklines, and shoulders covered (nothing strapless). Fair dress code must be appropriate for events attending. For example, boots/close-toed shoes, jeans, and a shirt can be worn for livestock shows. No smoking, alcohol, tobacco, or drug use. Limit the use of cell phones.

8. The Winner is required to assist during the events at the Marquette County Fair or any events they are not involved in.

If a contestant is named as Marquette County's Fairest of the Fair and, for any reason, cannot fulfill the duties of this position, as outlined above, for the entire term (one year), the Marquette County Fairest of the Fair will forfeit all cash prizes, scholarship monies, and any other prizes that have been awarded with the position. All of these awards will be returned to the Marquette County Fairboard within 21 days of termination of this position. At this point, the first runner-up will become eligible to serve as the Marquette County Fairest of the Fair.
