



## **Pheasant Run Swim Club Pavilion Party Reservation**

Pheasant Run is a great place to for members of the club to host a pool party for their friends and family members. Host your next Birthday, Graduation, Scouts, Team Sports, or any celebration here and your guests will enjoy:

- 4 hour reserved party area (once the party is over guests are invited to stay and use the club until closing time)
- Covered Pavilion complete with picnic tables, overhead fans, WIFI, and electric outlets
- Baby pool and playground
- Diving area and Water Slide
- 25 Meter Lap pool
- 3 – 4' shallow play area
- Basketball, Volleyball, Horseshoes, Shuffleboard and Gaga Court
- BBQ grills (charcoal not included)
- Catering packages available from Snack Shack

Cost:

- Full Pavilion \$75 (8 tables)
- Guest fee \$5 per person (\$3 Senior Citizens over 65, Free for children ages 3 and younger).
- No refunds given due to inclement weather after the party has started

Responsibilities:

- Party must be sponsored by a Pheasant Run Swim Club member
- Reservation must be made in person during regular pool hours
- \$50 deposit must be paid at time of reservation – Manager can accept credit card payment
- Complete guest list prior to the party along with guest contact number or guardian contact info shall be provided to the Manager.
- All guests must read and follow the POOL RULES along with following Covid-19 guidelines and signing the Covid-19 waiver available via link on prflyers.org.
- You are responsible for your own set-up and clean-up. Please place all trash and recyclables into the large trash cans provided. Pizza boxes should be stacked neatly next to the trash cans.
- **No swim diapers, floaties, or life jackets are allowed in the main pool.**

## Pheasant Run Swim Club

### General Club & Pool Rules

- The Club is not responsible for loss of, or damage to, personal property.
- The Club may be closed for maintenance operations, health conditions, inclement weather or other reasons deemed sufficient by the Management.
- All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult or responsible babysitter (14 years or older) at all times on Club premises.
- No intoxicants may be brought onto the Club premises.
- Pets are not allowed on Club property at any time.
- Members are not permitted in the office area unless called by pool staff.
- No glass containers of any kind are permitted anywhere on Club premises.
- Members are held responsible for the safety and conduct of their children, guests, and babysitters throughout all club buildings and grounds.
- Running, pushing, wrestling or causing undue disturbances or health/safety hazards in or about the pool areas are prohibited.
- No food or drink allowed on the pool deck area.
- Baby carriages are not permitted on the paved areas of the main pool.
- Any person showing evidence of skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, a cold, nasal or ear discharge or any communicable disease shall be refused admission into the pool.
- Sand, grass, gravel must be washed from feet prior to entering the pool.
- No diving allowed in any area of the pool except off the diving board.

#### Day Guests

- A guest privilege consists of the admission of one individual to the Club for one day.
- Members and their guests must be at least 12 years old to enter the Club without an adult.
- Conduct of guests, both adults and children, is the direct responsibility of the sponsoring member.
- Guest fees are collected in cash or check upon entry to the club and are non-refundable.
- Current guest fees: \$5.00 per person/ \$3.00 for senior citizen (age 65 or older) with proof of age.

#### The Main Pool

- No toys (except masks, snorkels, fins) are allowed in the main pool.
- No objects of any kind are to be thrown into the pool.
- Swimmers may not use any flotation devices.
- Excessive splashing, assessed at the discretion of the Lifeguards, is prohibited.
- Appropriate swimwear is required.
- Members are prohibited from conducting unnecessary conversation with the Lifeguard(s) on Duty.
- No diapers or swim pants are allowed in the main pool. Any child not completely toilet-trained is not permitted in the main pool under any circumstance. Violations resulting in closing of the pool are grounds for a fine of \$50, which must be remitted before family re-entry to the club.

#### Diving Board, Slide and Diving Blocks

- Each swimmer must wait until the previous diver/slider has cleared the well.
- Diving from the pool sides into the diving well is prohibited, unless permitted by a Lifeguard.
- Diving off the starting blocks without coach supervision is prohibited.
- Only 1 person is permitted on the diving board and/or the slide stairs at a time

#### Baby Pool Area

- The use of the wading (baby) pool is limited to infants and non-swimmers.
- Only soft, non-rigid toys are allowed in the wading pool.
- Children in the wading pool MUST be accompanied by an adult or babysitter of at least 14 years of age.
- Parents are required to keep non-toilet trained children dressed in suitable, highly protective diaper coverings.
