“Fresh berries and dried cherries come together with bergamot, lavender, mint... Toasted hazelnut and vanilla emerge as the wine leans savory with mushroom, black pepper, and cedar. The Merlot in the blend really shines here with rhubarb, cassis, and velvety softness.”

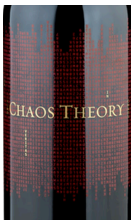

“This medium bodied red wine has nuances of blueberry and black current fruit typical of the Cabernet varietal, and a soft roundness on the palate derived from the Merlot in the blend.” 58% Cabernet Sauvignon, 34% Merlot, 8% Cabernet Franc

“...the wine opens with aromatics of boysenberry jam, violets, chocolate covered blueberry and hints of Cara Cara rind, graphite and brioche. Enveloping texture, chalky, drying tannins and an enduring finish bows out the wine.”

Cascading flavors of blackberries, black cherries, cappuccino, and tobacco lead to herbaceous earthiness with undertones of big game and fresh sage and rosemary”

Chateau Virgile Rhone, France 15, 34

“...intense with black fruit aromas complimented with hints of spice and olive notes. In the mouth, the wine is dominated by dense black cherry, plum, and cassis fruit flavors from the Syrah. The finish is complimented by hints of black pepper and red cherry notes from the Grenache. The Mourvèdre helps to provide the ripe tannins that give this wine its structure.”
60% Syrah, 30% Grenache, 10% Mourvèdre



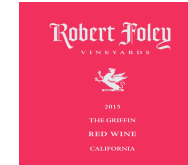
Chateau Croix Cardinal, St. Emilion Grand Cru 98

“...75% Merlot and 25% Cabernet Franc, Château Croix Cardinale has a beautiful, complex nose of red and black fruits, white truffle, flowers, and sandalwood. With an almost Pomerol-like elegance, it nevertheless has beautiful minerality and limestone character, ripe, sweet tannins, and a great finish. It’s beautifully done and shines on all accounts.”



Bodegas Muga Seleccion Especial Rioja Spain 118

“... a classical blend of the four red varieties from Rioja, Tempranillo, Garnacha, Mazuelo and Graciano with contained ripeness and good freshness. More than half of this blend are classic claret varieties (Cabernet, Malbec, Merlot, Petit Verdot), which marry with Rhone-rooted varieties (Syrah, Petite Sirah, Charbono).”
