## The Model T Ford Club International Foundation is pleased to announce the 20th Annual Scholarship Competition.

This competition will be administered by the Model T Ford Club International Foundation, Inc. (MTFCIFI). The MTFCIFI continues to realize the importance of promoting the youth within our organization and the Model T hobby by awarding scholarships to deserving high school seniors, or equivalent for an applicant outside of the USA.

- Must be a 2018 graduating high school senior, or equivalent for an applicant outside the USA.
- The applicant must be a member of the MTFCI or an immediate household family member must be a MTFCI member in good standing.
- The essay must be at least 1,000 words and all reference information must be properly cited to be considered.
- A completed MTFCIFI Scholarship Application, as published in the *Model T Times*, is required to accompany the applicant's essay submission.
- Applicant must submit an official transcript from his/her high school, or equivalent for outside the USA.
- Applications postmarked after May 31, 2018, will not be considered.
- The scholarship recipient must attend an accredited school or college of their choice beyond high school level.
- A check will be made out to the recipient of the scholarship and the school of their choice. Funds must be used for the 2018-2019 academic year and deposited by December 31, 2018.
- All decisions are final and there will be no private discussions regarding any candidate outside of the Board of Directors. All information remains strictly confidential.

### 2018 Essay Topic:

*The Model T Ford Club International (MTFCI) was founded in 1952. One of our missions from the beginning has been to bring together people who are passionate about, and share an enjoyment of, the Model T. In an essay of no less than 1,000 words, share how the MTFCI has impacted and enriched your life. Include three ideas of how, like in the past sixty-six years, the MTFCI can be relevant for the hobby and Model T enthusiasts for the next sixty-five.*
