## STUDENT dress code

## What we don't allow.

- Hoodies on sweat shirts or sweaters. (Boys & Girls)
- Shorts. (Boys & Girls)
- Sandals or high-heeled shoes. (Boys & Girls)
- Combat, hunting or work boots of any kind. (Boys & Girls)
- Over-sized clothing or belts. (Boys & Girls)
- Skirts more than 1" above the knee. (Girls)
- Baseball caps, caps or hats of any kind. (Boys & Girls)
- Excessive jewelry, i.e., nose rings, lip rings, or more than one set of earrings on girls.
- Poorly-groomed hair worn below the shirt collar. (Boys)
- Bright or loud hair colors (blue, purple, orange...etc.) (Boys & Girls)
- Bangs long enough to cover the eyes. (Boys & Girls)
- Torn/ripped jeans. (Boys & Girls)



School Dress Code: A set of rules, written and posted, specifying the required manner of dress at school.

## What we look for:

- The NHHSA uniform shirt (in approved colors). (Boys & Girls)
- Well-fitting slacks, pants, or jeans (Boys & Girls)
- Skirts (no more than 1" above the knee) or capris. (Girls)
