# Kittitas County Prehospital Care Protocols

Subject: OXYTOCIN (PITOCIN)

## ACTION:

Causes uterine contractions, causes lactation, slows post-partum vaginal bleeding.

#### **INDICATIONS:**

Post-partum vaginal bleeding.

# **CONTRAINDICATIONS:**

Any condition other than post-partum bleeding, cesarean section.

### **PRECAUTIONS:**

It is essential to assure that the placenta has delivered and that there is not another fetus present. Overdosage can cause uterine rupture and hypertension.

### SIDE EFFECTS:

Anaphylaxis and cardiac arrhythmias.

# DOSAGE:

IM: 3-10 units

IV: <u>10-20 units in 1000 mL Normal Saline</u> administered to uterine response.

#### **ROUTE:**

IM and IV drip
