(food for thought) (Bulletin 6 November, 2022) Gospel: Luke 20:27-38. "A Clearer Focus"

Life after death has always been an "unknown" to mankind and the unknown is our enemy. There is a built-in sense of fear and uncertainty that accompanies the fact that we do not know "the day or the hour." It's hard to plan for a surprise or the unexpected. We ask questions about the resurrection because we want reassurance that there is a place of unending joy, freed from this world's pain and sadness. We look for help to reinforce our faith as we face the end of our lives. We try to fill in the blanks, drawing from daily life or from our imaginations and try to paint a picture of what's ahead. The Gospel concepts of resurrection and new life speak to these basic longings.

Hope in the resurrection gives meaning to our present lives and strengthens us in times of trial and uncertainty. With a resurrection lens we can view what our world considers valuable, seeks after and clings to from a different perspective. We get a new focus on life through resurrection lens. Everything we do on this earth should be built upon this faith and hope. We have been chosen to live this life with great hope and faith. We believe that Jesus is the Life and the Resurrection. And, we believe that when we die, we are so fully engulfed in God's embrace that we become a part of his existence in ways we could never imagine and in ways that we can never describe. It is because of this that we can articulate the good news that living our lives in love has an eternal connectedness with living on in God after death.
