

RampShot *with Slapback*

Are you ready to take your RampShot game to the next level? RampShot has now released a new method of play for advanced players that is sure to add a whole new level of excitement to your game. It's called, RampShot with Slapback! While traditional point values have always been a single (1 point) or a triple (3 points), RampShot with Slapback gives your team the ability to now earn a double (2 points). This fun new rule is a game changer! New strategies and even more teamwork will put your team to the test! Here's how it works;

How to Score a Double (2 points)

When the Shooter tosses the ball and the ball bounces off the top of the opposite ramp, the Playmaker now has a choice; The Playmaker can still catch the ball for 1 point or they can go for 2 points by slapping the ball, in midair, back to the shooter. If the Shooter catches the ball before it hits the ground, that team will earn 2 points.

- * The Playmaker cannot bobble the ball before slapping it back to their teammate. The Slapback must be made on first contact.
- * The Shooter must wait for the ball to bounce off the opposite ramp before making a move to catch the ball. Once the ball hits the opposite ramp, the Shooter can move around freely behind their own ramp to attempt a catch for a double. Similar to a sideline catch in football, the Shooter must have both feet behind their own ramp when making a catch to count as 2 points.
- * The Shooter may not cross over in front of their own ramp at any time.
- * The Stealer can intercept a Slapback which will count as a steal.
- * The Stealer is never allowed to go past their opponent's ramp but can move anywhere else in the playing area to make a play during a Slapback, including retreating behind their own ramp to make an attempt at catching a Slapback for the steal.
- * During a Slapback, the Shooter and Stealer can only make an attempt at catching the ball. Some contact may occur when both players are going for the ball, but grabbing or pushing the opposing player to prevent that player from catching the ball is not allowed and will result in the following penalty;

If the Shooter does not attempt to catch the ball but rather grabs or pushes the Stealer, a steal will be awarded to the Stealer. If the Stealer does not make an attempt to catch the ball but rather grabs or pushes the Shooter, 2 points will be awarded to the Shooter.
