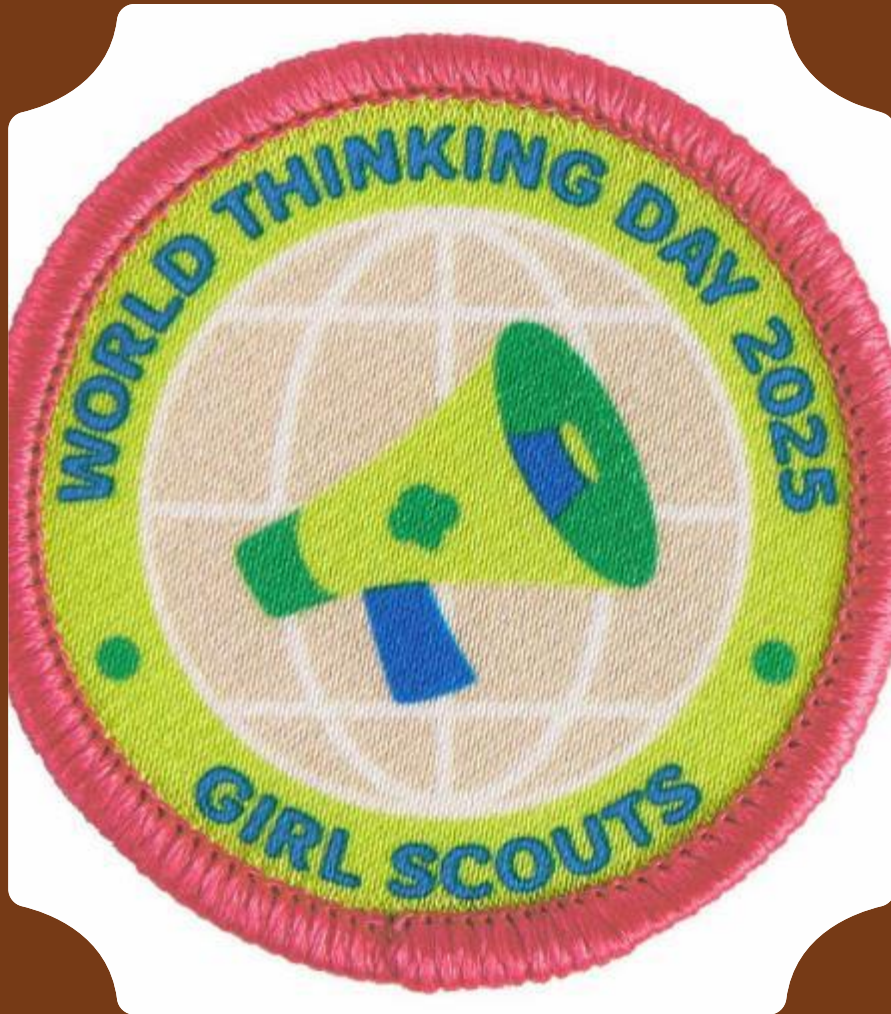

 - **Event Volunteers at events that are hosting girls for two days within one month (example: Day Camp)**

- **Live Scan fingerprinting cannot be shared so even if you have a live scan with your job or other organization, you must complete it with GSGLA as well.**
 - **Volunteers will not need to live scan again as long as membership is maintained each year.**

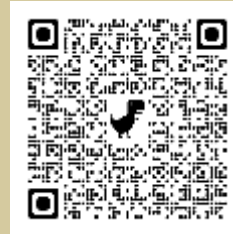

We start the 2025-26 renewal off on April 1st!

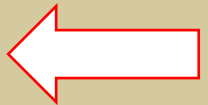
