Elsie S. Weatherington, Ph.D. serves as Dean of the University Libraries at Virginia State University. In addition to serving as University Librarian, she managed academic computing and the media center for several years. She formerly worked as Director of the Information Exchange at Travelers Insurance Company and Manager of data services at an online library systems firm.

Dr. Weatherington is an alumna of Virginia State University. She earned a Master's Degree in Library and Information Science from Drexel University and the Ph.D. in Library Science from the University of Pittsburgh. In her educational pursuits she earned a certificate in Human Relations Counseling and has participated in numerous leadership institutes.

She is a founding member of the HBCU Library Alliance which was created to preserve the history of all historically black colleges and universities for posterity. She also holds memberships in the American Library Association, the Association of College and Research Libraries and other library and information industry and higher education organizations. She has received the Southeastern Library Network Award for Preservation and Access to Information. Dr. Weatherington hosted and co-chaired the 2009 Virginia Network Conference at Virginia State University and is the current State Coordinator.
