

Our 2022 HOLIDAY CAMP is just around the corner Registration begins on Tuesday, November 15th.

'STUFF' ABOUT the THREE DAY MINI-CAMP BEFORE CHRISTMAS

1) The first camp is a three day camp that runs December 19, 20 and 21.

You can register for all three days and receive a discount OR you can register day to day. Each day we will celebrate the theme of the camp in short shows, skits, crafts, and all other activities. We know several districts are still in school, so this mini-camp is intended for those whose last day of school is December 16th.

Monday the 19th will be a **MUSICAL THEATER** themed camp.

Tuesday the 20th will be a **CELEBRATION OF THE LION KING** camp.

Wednesday the 21st will be a **LIP SYNC CHALLENGE** themed camp

These three day mini-camps will run from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily. We will be offering early drop off at 8:00 a.m. for an additional \$5.00 a day. We will also offer late pick up at 6:00 p.m. for an additional \$5.00 a day.

CAMP AGES: 7 to 14 years

MINI-CAMP ENROLLEMENT FEES:

Single day camps are \$40.00. Enroll in all 3 camp days and the cost is \$100.00. That's a savings of \$20.00.

WHAT IS PROVIDED FOR THE MINI-CAMPS?

The camps will provide all the craft supplies; two snacks a day, any costumes that the kids will use and a DVD download of the show or skit the campers will be performing at the end of the day. Camps will be taught by Broadway Theater owners, Randall Hickman, Douglas Davis and several of their summer camp directors. This is the first year we have offered a Christmas Break Camp. Our November camp is going to be HUGE, so we are optimistic that you and your child will want to be a part of this camp. In order for the daily Mini-Camps to proceed we must have 20 kids between the ages of 7 and 14 years enrolled for each day. Maximum enrollment is 40 kids per day. ‘STUFF’ about the two week PETER PAN camp

2) SO, TELL ME ABOUT THE TWO WEEK PETER PAN CAMP.

This camp starts on December 26th and runs through January 6th

This two week camp will run from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily.

You can register for three single days each week if you don't, or can't do the full week.

Part time campers will participate in everything we do in the camp except for the production of **PETER PAN** which will be performed LIVE for the parents on January 6th, 7th and 8th in the Broadway Theater. However, if your child enrolls in the camp for at least 3 days each week – and can be in attendance ALL DAY on January 6th - they WILL be able to participate in the show. Only campers enrolled for all 10 days will get the large speaking roles. Campers that are enrolled for 3 days each week will be pirates, lost boys and Indians.

CAMP AGES: 7 to 14 years

ENROLLEMENT FEES:

Single day enrollments are \$40.00 a day.

Enrollment fee for the full two week **PETER PAN CAMP** is \$250.00 per child.

The camps will provide all the craft supplies; two snacks a day, and the costume your child will wear for the show.

The show will perform for the parents on:

Friday, January 6th at 6:00 p.m.

Saturday, January 7th at 2:00 and 5:00 p.m.

Sunday, January 8th at 2:00 and 5:00 p.m.

Our shows are not just little skits with homemade sets. We go all out with our shows, sets, costumes, lighting and sound.

WHAT HAPPENS THE FIRST DAY of the PETER PAN CAMP?

On the first day we all get to know each other and the kids will be asked to sing a one minute song for the auditions. We then take them through some acting exercises where they get to perform commercials with their fellow cast members. We go through improvisations and they learn how to fill out a theater resume. Just before lunch, we audition for the show. Once the show is cast everyone gets a script and a music CD to take home and rehearse. The second day of class we start putting their show together! Every day of the camp we will do a craft that ties in with the show - costume design, make-up design; a specialty prop, etc. On the final day of camp the kids will rehearse in costume and on the set. We will set lights, film the show, take photos of the kids on the set and get ready for our FIRST LIVE performance for family at 6:00 p.m.

‘STUFF YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR THE MINI-CAMP and PETER PAN CAMP

1) COVID PROTOCOLS

We are now following the San Diego Unified School Districts recommendations: We no longer require masks, but we highly recommend it.

2) PURCHASING SNACKS

We provide a morning and afternoon snack and during lunch the kids can purchase items from our concessions stand for \$1.50 a piece. As always, lunch must be provided by the parent.

3) HOW DO I REGISTER?

To sign your child up, you can use the REGISTRATION FORM located on the DRAMA CAMP / WORKSHOP page of our web site or call the offices 7 days a week between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. daily. (760) 806-7905. Your credit card will not be charged until the PETER PAN CAMP reaches 20 kids. We **MUST** have 20 kids to make this camp fly. PETER PAN has 20 LARGE speaking roles, so we have to have 20 kids to make this camp go.

5) WHAT DO I NEED TO SEND WITH MY CHILD TO CAMP EACH DAY?

Below are the items your child needs to provide every day

A small snack.

A water bottle.

3 ring binder (for their script).

Two sharpened pencils.

We provide everything else from markers, to scissors; from crayons to glue.

All the campers will be assigned a locker that they can keep their lunch and backpacks in during their stay with us.
