DESCRIPTION: Pearson designed this attractive 52" H-52 model bow to compete with Bear's Kodiak Magnum. Has a number of higher-end features such as black and white overlays on the back of the riser, dual-sided tip overlays, and beveled arrow rest. Great looking and performing recurve. Zebrawood riser. Substantial grip. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string.

This bow sold for \$65 in '70, which translates to \$540 in 2025 inflation adjusted dollars.
