**Florida (+13) pulled a huge upset over Ole Miss.** However, Ole Miss had a dominant 464-344 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. The Rebels were stopped on downs at the Florida 11-yard line. They missed a 34-yard FG. Ole Miss fumbled a punt, that set up a 4-play 2-yard FG "drive". Ole Miss also got stopped on downs at the Florida 10-yard line.

**Connecticut (+10) covered vs Syracuse in a 31-24 loss.** Syracuse had a 538-352 yard edge but missed 2 FG's and had 2 TD's called back by penalty. UConn got the back-door TD with 1:29 left.

**Iowa State (-6.5) only beat Utah 31-28.** However, Iowa State had dominant 405-224 yard and 25-9 first down edges. Utah got a 87-yard "Pick 6" and a blocked punt TD.

**Fresno State (-3.5) beat Colorado State 28-22.** However, Colorado State had a 422-344 yard edge. Colorado State was stopped on down at the Fresno 6, stopped on downs at the Fresno 43 and intercepted at the Fresno 34.

**Appalachian State (+7.5) upset James Madison 34-20.** However, James Madison had a 400-361 yard edge but were -2 in TO's.

**Illinois (+2.5) won a wild back and forth game at Rutgers 38-31.** In the final seconds, Illinois missed a FG but Rutgers took a timeout to ice the kicker and the play didn't count. Illinois then elected to not to kick a FG after the timeout and got a "Hail Mary" TD pass instead.

**San Diego State led Utah State 13-0.** However, Utah State would score the next 41 points in a blowout win.

**New Mexico State (+3.5) upset Middle Tennessee 36-21.** However, Middle Tennessee had a 447-382 yard edge but were -2 in TO's that included a "Pick 6".

**Stanford led rival Cal 21-7 in the second half before Cal scored the game's final 17 points.**

**North Texas led East Carolina 21-0 but would lose 40-28.**

**Arkansas State (-3) beat UL-Monroe 28-21.** However, ULM was stopped on downs at the Arkansas State 26. ULM fumbled at the Arkansas State 4. Meanwhile, Arkansas State got a pair of TD's on 3rd & 12 that would have been a FG attempt and a punt instead.

### Bad Beats

**South Carolina was a 42.5-point favorite vs FCS Wofford.** South Carolina led 35-12 in the fourth quarter. South Carolina got a couple of long TD drives to make it 49-12. Instead of taking a knee, South Carolina scored a TD with :09 left to win 56-12. Yikes.

**Miami (-23.5) beat Wake Forest 42-14.** However, it was only a 20-14 lead in the middle of the fourth quarter. Miami got a TD and a 2-point conversion. Wake then fumbled the ensuing kickoff that set up Miami for a short-field TD drive to make it 35-14. Miami stopped Wake on downs in the red zone and then went the length of the field to get the front-door cover TD.

**Georgia Tech (-7.5) beat NC State 30-29.** However, NC State had a 400-391 yard edge but were -2 in TO's that included a 21-yard "Pick 6". Another Wolf Pack turnover set up GT for a 1-play 3-yard TD "drive". NC State also just missed a FG on the final play of the game.

## **Games in Rotation Order**

## **HOME TEAM IN CAPS**

### **Thursday, November 28th**

**TULANE 35 Memphis 22.** Both teams off a bye and Tulane has the AAC Championship game on deck. Tulane is 9-2 ATS on the season with an average cover of 13.5 points per game. They are the best Group of 5 team in the country as we'd make them a 2-point favorite over Boise in our power ratings. The Green Wave rank 10th in ypg margin and 7th in scoring margin, have the better coach and have played a tougher schedule than Memphis. Not surprised the early week money is on Tulane, however we're hearing whispers of a Memphis "buy" order especially if it goes above 14.

### **Friday, November 29th**

**OHIO 36 Ball State 20.** Ohio is in the MAC Championship game with a win and would play the winner of Miami/Bowling Green. They've had a remarkable season considering they returned only 5 starters and ranked No. 130 in our experience rankings. Ball State is just playing out the season with an interim coach as they rank No. 130 in ypp margin. We lean with Ohio but prefer the OVER which is 8-2-1 in Ball State games this year by an average of 11.7 ppg.

**BOWLING GREEN 21 Miami, OH 20.** The winner goes to the MAC Championship game. Miami has the better yards per play margin and has played the tougher schedule. Keep an eye on the weather (freezing and windy conditions are expected). Also keep an eye out for the status Bowling Green TE Harold Fannin Jr, who leads the nation in receiving.

**COLORADO 40 Oklahoma State 24.** This line was Oklahoma State -3 in the summer. Colorado's 8 game cover streak came to an end last week as they were run over by Kansas. They no longer control their destiny in the Big 12 race and need a win and a few upsets. The good news is Travis Hunter is a -800 favorite to win the Heisman. Oklahoma State has lost 8 straight games going 1-7 ATS in the process. Pass.

**WISCONSIN 23 Minnesota 21.** The winner of the game receives Paul Bunyan's Axe. The two teams have split the last 6 meetings after Wisconsin had won 14 in a row. The Badgers need a win to get to bowl eligibility. Minnesota has been the better team in the stats and nearly upset Penn State last week. Wisconsin has been a major disappointment and Fickell needs to make the right hire at OC this time. We haven't bet the game yet.

**BOISE STATE 38 Oregon State 18.** Boise State will host the Mountain West Championship game next week likely against UNLV. The Broncos have had a few close calls though in recent weeks including last week at Wyoming. Meanwhile, Oregon State is off their best win of the season and can get to a bowl with a win. A sharp group bet Oregon State on Tuesday but we're not involved.

**Texas State 31 SOUTH ALABAMA 30.** South Alabama needs a win and UL-Lafayette loss to get to the Sun Belt Championship game. Texas State head coach GJ Kinne just got big raise and extension but we think he's done a poor job this season. Texas State has been favored in all 11 games but are 6-5 and last week lost outright as a 23-point favorite to Georgia State. Texas State is Top 20 in ypp, ypg and scoring margins and this should be one of the more entertaining games of the week.

**OLE MISS 43 Mississippi State 17.** Ole Miss is one of the best teams in the country. They rank No. 1 in yards per play margin, No. 2 in yards per game margin and yet lost 3 games outright as a favorite including last week in Florida. They'll be deservedly sitting home for the playoffs. Mississippi State has 9 losses this season but only one by more than 24. Our power ratings like Ole Miss here but question their frame of mind.

**Liberty 26 SAM HOUSTON STATE 24.** If Liberty wins this game, they travel to Jacksonville State next week. Meanwhile, Sam Houston State needs a win and a WKU loss. Liberty is the better team in the stats and notably had 419 rushing yards last week. However, they have played the weakest schedule in the FBS. We lean Sam Houston at +3 or more.

**SAN JOSE STATE 29 Stanford 26.** After the bye, Stanford has played their best ball of the season, upsetting Louisville as a 3-TD underdog and nearly upsetting Cal last week as a 2-TD dog. Stanford led 21-7 in the second half. Meanwhile, San Jose was crushed by UNLV worse than the final last Friday. San Jose is far superior in the stats but Stanford has played the much tougher schedule.

**IOWA 24 Nebraska 19.** Nebraska clinched bowl eligibility for the first time in 8 years last week. It will be a taller task at night in Kinnick. Iowa is the better team in the stats (+0.7 vs -0.1 in ypp margin) despite playing a similar strength of schedule. We lean OVER which is 9-2 in Iowa games this year by an average of 7.2 points per game.

**GEORGIA 36 Georgia Tech 18.** Georgia is 0-6 ATS this year laying 2 TD's or more. They have the SEC Championship game on deck. Georgia Tech has extra time to prep after a thrilling win over NC State last Thursday. Georgia Tech is the better running team (No. 44 in rush vs No. 98) and that's where our lean is.

**CENTRAL FLORIDA 29 Utah 20.** This could be the final game for Utah head coach Kyle Whittingham. The Utes have lost 7 straight games since opening 4-0. Meanwhile, UCF ranks No. 17 in ypp margin but somehow are also 4-7 on the season. Luke Bottari will be the 4th different Utah QB to start this season. Pass.

**COLORADO STATE 31 Utah State 26.** We like what we're seeing from the Utah State offense. They've topped 300 rush yards and 40 points in each of the last two weeks. Last week they trailed San Diego State 13-0 and then reeled off 41 straight. Colorado State needs a win and a UNLV loss to get to the Mountain West Championship game at Boise. We lean Utah State.

**EAST CAROLINA 30 Navy 28.** Keep an eye on the status of Navy QB Horvath who was banged up Navy's last game vs Tulane prior to the bye. ECU has won 4 straight with interim coach Blake Harrell and they've decided to promote him. We're not sure that's the best move as the schedule has really lightened. Still, the offense is averaging 46 ppg in the win streak. We lean OVER especially if Horvath plays.

### **Saturday, November 30th**

**ARMY 30 Utsa 25.** Teams are 0-9-1 ATS after facing Notre Dame this season failing to cover by 12.3 ppg. It makes sense for a few reasons considering teams put more into a game against Notre Dame than most. Also this year's ND team is extremely physical and it took its toll on Army last week with multiple starters going down during the game. Army QB Daily ran it 39 times including 11 on the final drive when down 42 points. Will he be 100%? UTSA is playing their best ball of the season with 3 straight wins and covers. Army has the AAC Championship game and Navy on deck. We like UTSA.

**Tcu 30 CINCINNATI 28.** Cincinnati has lost 4 straight games and SU and ATS. Head coach Scott Satterfield should be on the hot seat especially if they lose this game and fail to make a bowl. TCU has quietly won 4 of their last 5 games. The Horned Frogs are far superior in ypp margin (+1.3 vs +0.1) but Cincy the is much better running team (No. 39 vs No. 116). A sharp group bet TCU -3 on Tuesday but we lean Bearcats.

**GEORGIA STATE 29 Coastal Carolina 28.** Coastal is sitting on 5 wins. They are the better team in the stats (+0.1 vs -0.6 in ypp margin) but Georgia State has played the tougher schedule. Georgia State is coming off their best performance of the season as they upset Texas State as 23-point underdogs. We don't see much value.

**CLEMSON 26 South Carolina 25.** We think South Carolina is the right side in this one. The Gamecocks have played the much tougher schedule (No. 18 vs No. 62) and have a slightly better ypp margin (+1.3 vs +1.2). They've won 5 straight and have a huge matchup edge here. Their Top 5 DL in the country vs a banged up Clemson OL. The problem is the market agrees and this line was as high as Clemson -5 on Sunday. We prefer the OVER at current.

**BOSTON COLLEGE 28 Pittsburgh 25.** After their 7-0 start, Pitt has lost 4 straight and were blown out by Louisville last week. QB Eli Holstein is out for this one. Meanwhile, Boston College is now bowl eligible and have covered 4 in a row. The offense has taken off with QB James. All the early week money has been on BC here. However, our ratings lean toward Pitt and the OVER.

**NORTH CAROLINA 30 NC State 26.** Mack Brown was fired on Tuesday but will still be allowed to coach in this game. It was deserved as the Tar Heels have only covered 2 games this year and his age was being used to negatively recruit against him and NC. Meanwhile, NC State is still sitting on 5 wins after their heart-breaking loss to Georgia Tech. They have won 3 straight in the rivalry. We lean OVER.

**Florida 30 FLORIDA STATE 16.** Florida State was an 11.5-point favorite in this game during the summer. Now they find themselves a 15-point underdog. We've downgraded Florida State more than any team in our power ratings since 2018 Louisville. Florida is off back-to-back outright upset wins over LSU and Ole Miss and we have them up to No. 20 in our power ratings. Still, we can't get our numbers to this spread. Lean FSU.

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS 30 Central Michigan 17.** This will be the final game for CMU head coach Jim McElwain who is retiring. NIU is 6-5 on the season but somehow have outgained their opponents by 100 ypg. Kickoff temp is expected to be in the 20's! We didn't bet it.

**North Texas 36 TEMPLE 26.** North Texas was sitting at 5-1 with their only loss to Texas Tech. They've lost 5 straight games but all of them are bowl teams and they're taking a major step down in class here. Temple is just playing out the season with an interim coach. We don't see much value.

**Tennessee 30 VANDERBILT 19.** A win by Tennessee here and the Volunteers are likely heading to the CFB Playoffs. Easier said than done vs a Vanderbilt team that is 7-1 ATS as an underdog this year. Tough laying double-digits with a Tennessee offense that is averaging 23 points per game in SEC play compared to 62 in non-conference action.

**Connecticut 31 MASSACHUSETTS 20.** UMass gave a great effort vs Georgia last week and were only trailing 31-21 in the middle of the third quarter. UConn had a misleading 7-point loss to Syracuse as the Orange outgained them by nearly 200 yards. UConn has a chance for their first 8-win season since 2010. We lean OVER.

**Miami, FL 40 SYRACUSE 30.** Should be a fun one. Miami has the No. 1 offense in the country in yards per play, yards per game and scoring. Syracuse offense is averaging 454 yards per game. Miami got another misleading blowout win last week as they outscored Wake 22-0 in the final 8 minutes. They have not been as dominant away from home with a pair of close wins vs Cal and Louisville and a loss to Georgia Tech. We lean Syracuse and OVER.

**VIRGINIA TECH 29 Virginia 22.** Both teams sit at 5-6 needing a win for bowl eligibility. Both come in reeling. UVA has lost 5 of 6 while VT has lost 3 straight. Both coaches are feeling some deserved heat. VT is better in the stats (+0.3 vs -0.6) but have been banged up at QB. As of press time Kyron Drones is questionable. Lean OVER.

**WESTERN MICHIGAN 31 Eastern Michigan 25.** Both teams sitting at 5-6. Eastern has lost 4 straight while Western has lost 3 straight. WMU is a full yard better in yards per play margin and has played the tougher schedule. EMU is 28-8 ATS as a road underdog the last 10 years. We didn't bet side or total.

**JAMES MADISON 30 Marshall 25.** Marshall has the best ATS record in the country at 9-1-1 with an average cover of 6.4 ppg. If they win here, they will clinch a berth in the Sun Belt Championship game. It will be a tall task considering JMU is much better in the stats (+1.1 vs +0.6 in ypp margin). We bet JMU and still like them at -3.5.

**CHARLOTTE 31 Uab 28.** Just when you thought it was all over for Trent Dilfer, UAB has actually played better as of late highlighted by a 40-14 win over Rice last week as a 7-point home underdog. The Blazers are the better team in the stats (-0.1 vs -0.9 ypp margin) and Charlotte is playing with an interim coach in Tim Brewster who led them to a win last week. A sharp group took UAB +3 on Tuesday. We're passing.

**GEORGIA SOUTHERN 31 Appalachian State 28.** These are two long-time rivals back to their So Con days in Division 1-AA. App State leads the series 6-4 since the two teams both joined the FBS in 2014. App State is sitting at 5-5 needing a win to get to a bowl while Georgia Southern needs a win and a Marshall loss to get to the Sun Belt Championship game. We haven't bet it yet but our numbers are showing value to the UNDER.

**Duke 29 WAKE FOREST 25.** We don't think Manny Diaz has gotten enough love this season. The market (including us) hammered their win total UNDER to the point it was sitting at just 5. They have a shot to win 9 games here. Wake will be sitting at home for the holidays again. We didn't bet side or total.

**OHIO STATE 34 Michigan 13.** The Game. Michigan has won three straight in the rivalry. They've dominated the line of scrimmage in each. We don't expect that to continue here. Yes, the vibes are good right now in Ann Arbor. They got the No. 1 recruit in the country coming in at QB. They are off their best performance of the season in smashing Northwestern. However, Ohio State now ranks No. 1 with some margin in our power ratings. Their DL whipped Indiana last week. Anytime you have a big favorite you have to ask yourself, is their motivation for margin. Obviously, Ohio State has that and we just saw them punch in a TD in the final seconds vs Indiana when they could've taken a knee. I do find it interesting that the OVER is on a 10-0 run in the series. You normally think defense, run the football, bad weather but that's not been the case. Speaking of weather, kickoff temperature is supposed to be 26 degrees. This is tied with 2014 as the largest point spread in the series in our records that go back to 1976. Our numbers lean OVER.

**Old Dominion 30 ARKANSAS STATE 25.** We continue to think Arkansas State is a fraud. Last week, they were outgained again and somehow won vs ULM. Arkansas State is 7-4 and yet are -1.4 in yards per play margin. No. 124 in the country. ODU is 4-7 and are flat in ypp margin. That's why the Monarchs are laying points. † **Illinois 26 NORTHWESTERN 19.** @Wrigley Field in Chicago. Northwestern is off their worst performance of the season. An embarrassing 50-6 loss to Michigan. Illinois has lived a charmed life this year and last week hit a Hail Mary TD pass after Rutgers tried to ice their kicker on a missed FG. We lean with the underdog provided you can get the hook.

**MICHIGAN STATE 24 Rutgers 22.** Michigan State is 5-6 and needs a win to get to a bowl. Rutgers is already sitting at bowl eligibility and are coming off a heart-breaking loss to Illinois. Michigan State is better in the stats (+0.0 vs -0.6 in ypp margin) and have played the tougher schedule (No. 26 vs No. 54).

**FIU 31 Middle Tennessee 22.** Middle Tennessee is a miserable 3-8 SU and 3-8 ATS and suffered a 15-point home loss as a favorite to New Mexico State last week. FIU is actually +0.4 in ypp margin this year. Early money is on FIU and we're a part of it.

**Arizona State 31 ARIZONA 23.** If Arizona State wins, they are in the Big 12 Championship game. Remarkable considering their win total was only 4.5 and were 125/1 to win the conference in the summer. Speaking of the summer, we bet Arizona State +17 in this game. Arizona's season has been a nightmare as the Wildcats are nation-worst 2-9 ATS. They can salvage it here with an upset. We thought Arizona State played tight after the big lead last week. Will that be the case here? Lean Arizona.

**BYU 27 Houston 14.** After starting 9-0 BYU has suffered back-to-back close losses. If all four 6-2 Big 12 teams win this week, we will get Arizona State vs Iowa State so BYU is going to need some help. They've taken some money in this matchup this week. While Houston's offense has struggled all year, their defense is allowing only 22 ppg and it's tough doubles vs them. Pass.

**Air Force 24 SAN DIEGO STATE 21.** Air Force has been a hot team lately with 3 straight wins and 4 straight covers. That's coming off a 0-7 ATS start. Tough laying more than a FG on the road even if San Diego State comes in losers of 5 straight.

**UCLA 30 Fresno State 19.** This is our biggest power ratings disparity of the week. A lot of it has to do with schedule as UCLA has played the 2nd toughest while Fresno ranks No. 99. Will UCLA be motivated here considering they're coming off a tough loss to arch rival USC? The market doesn't think so.

**South Florida 30 RICE 27.** Rice is actually better in the stats (+0.3 vs +0.0 in ypp margin) and have played the much tougher schedule (No. 80 vs No. 105). Usually that screams big bet on Rice and our power ratings agree. However, Rice is playing with an interim and just lost 40-14 as a 7-point favorite. USF is playing their best ball of the season. We like OVER.

**TEXAS TECH 34 West Virginia 31.** Both teams have had somewhat disappointing seasons. West Virginia fans want Neal Brown fired but the reality is that they've been an underdog in 8 of their 11 games this season and only one game have been favored by more than 1.5-points and yet sit at 6-5. Texas Tech has a chance at an 8-4 season but did have a misleading win over Oklahoma State last week. Our ratings lean WVU but we haven't bet the game yet.

**WESTERN KENTUCKY 29 Jacksonville State 28.** Jacksonville State has already clinched a home game for the Sun Belt Championship game next week so we question their motivation here. WKU needs a win and a Liberty loss. However, WKU's defense has allowed 331, 209 and 419 rushing yards the last 3 games and face a Jacksonville State rush offense that averages 317 rush ypg in CUSA play. Lean UNDER.

**TROY 33 Southern Miss 17.** It's tough laying this kind of number with a Troy team that is 3-8. However, the last 4 games they are +75 ypg and playing like a Top 80 team. Southern Miss showed more fight last week in a cover vs South Alabama. Lean dog.

**LSU 27 Oklahoma 21.** This game got a lot more interesting after last week's results. Oklahoma shocked the CFB world with a 24-3 win over Alabama as a 2-TD underdog. It was legit too as Oklahoma had a 257-70 rushing yard edge. The Sooners are featuring Jackson Arnold more in the QB run game and that's what LSU's defense struggles against...mobile QB's. We need a "+7" to get involved on the game though.

**Florida Atlantic 30 TULSA 29.** Both teams are playing with interim coaches and our power ratings have FAU by 1.3 and the line is 1.5. Pass.

**Kansas 30 BAYLOR 29.** Neither will make the Big 12 Championship game but these could be the two best teams in the conference right now. Baylor has won and covered 5 straight games. Kansas has also covered 5 straight games and have won 3 straight games vs Top 25 teams. They became the first ever to do that as a losing team. The Jayhawks still need a win to get to bowl eligibility. We agree with the market flip with them going underdog to favorite. However, at current, we don't see as much value other than a lean on the UNDER.

**SMU 34 California 21.** Tough to gauge the motivation of either team here. Cal just had a thrilling come-from-behind win over their arch rival and clinched bowl eligibility. Meanwhile, SMU has already clinched a spot in the ACC Championship game. A win here could bolster their at-large bid if they were to lose next week. We're not involved.

**Texas 27 TEXAS A&M 21.** The game with the most implications this week at the top of CFB. The winner clinches a bid to the SEC Championship game. Texas A&M comes in off the heart-breaking 4OT loss to Auburn. The expectation is that Quinn Ewers will start here for Texas but he won't be 100% after suffering an ankle sprain last week. This should be one of the best atmospheres in CFB this season as these two bitter rivals have not met since 2011. The line is in a dead-zone right now at 5-5.5. Obviously, we'd like to lay 3 (which we did on Sunday) or take +7.

**Louisville 27 KENTUCKY 24.** Kentucky has won 5 straight in the rivalry and find themselves more than a FG underdog. Both teams have been "Jekyll and Hyde" this season. Louisville does rank No. 14 in ypp margin while Kentucky ranks No. 98. Kentucky has played the more difficult schedule. They will start true freshman Cutter Boley here. We bet Louisville -2.5 on the Boley news.

**MISSOURI 27 Arkansas 26.** Arkansas is +1.1 in ypp margin while playing the No. 30 schedule. Meanwhile, Missouri is +0.0 in ypp margin while playing the No. 56 schedule. We think Arkansas is the better team. They're also the better running team (No. 34 vs No. 59) and we love running dogs.

**ALABAMA 34 Auburn 20.** The dynamics of this game changed greatly since last week. Alabama has went from a sure-fire CFB Playoff berth and likely SEC Championship game appearance to now no SEC Championship game and likely no playoffs. That's what a 24-3 loss as a 2-TD favorite will do to you. Meanwhile, Auburn is off the thrilling 4OT upset win over Texas A&M. They can clinch bowl eligibility with a win. Auburn actually has a better ypp margin (+1.9 vs +1.8) and better ypg margin (+112.9 vs +94.9). However, Alabama has played the much tougher schedule (No. 7 vs No. 49). Our power ratings love Alabama here.

**IOWA STATE 26 Kansas State 24.** If Iowa State wins, they're likely in the Big 12 Championship game. Kansas State feels like the right side though. The Wildcats have the better ypp margin (+1.2 vs +0.8) and have played the tougher schedule (No. 25 vs No. 40). Finally, Kansas State is the better running team (No. 16 vs No. 66). Need "+3" though.

**UL-Lafayette 30 UL-MONROE 20.** ULM should have clinched bowl eligibility last week. They got stopped on downs at the Arkansas State 26, fumbled at the Arkansas State 4-yard line and Arkansas State score a pair of TD's on 3rd & long. ULL needs a win and they clinch a SBC Championship berth. ULL does rank No. 13 in ypp margin but is playing with a backup QB.

**OREGON 36 Washington 16.** Both teams come in off a bye. Oregon is the only remaining unbeaten team left. Some may think we have them too low at No. 3 in our power ratings but the Ducks rank only No. 9 in ypp margin, No. 8 in ypg margin and No. 12 in scoring margin. They do have motivation for margin here considering Dan Lanning is 0-3 vs Washington in his career. Even with the Big Ten Championship game on deck, we lean Oregon. Lean OVER.

**INDIANA 41 Purdue 14.** Obviously, Indiana was exposed last week in Columbus. However, the Hoosiers benefited from several SEC upsets and appear safe as far as the CFB Playoffs go. That's provided they take care of business here. This is the largest favorite role ever for either team in the series.

**PENN STATE 37 Maryland 14.** The CFB Playoff committee loves Penn State as they have them at No. 4. We have Penn State No. 8. They barely survived Minnesota last week but kudos to James Franklin for his aggressive calls in the fourth quarter highlighted by the fake punt. We don't expect much effort from Maryland who at 4-7, has nothing to play for. Still, this line seems expensive.

**NEW MEXICO STATE 26 Ute 24.** The Battle of I-10. Both teams have first-year coaches that could use a rivalry win to end the season in a positive way. UTEP is -1.0 in ypp margin while playing the No. 107 schedule while New Mexico state -1.8 in ypp margin playing the No. 110 schedule. Lean UTEP.

**LOUISIANA TECH 29 Kennesaw State 16.** Kennesaw State shockingly fires their coach. Half their team enters the transfer portal (but elected to finish the season) and we've seen Kennesaw give two great efforts vs Sam Houston and FIU and got the upset last week. Louisiana Tech has the much better ypp margin (+0.0 vs -1.9) and should be better than their 4-7 record. We lean OVER.

**WASHINGTON STATE 37 Wyoming 20.** It looks like Wyoming QB Kaden Anderson will be out for this game and they'll go back to Evan Svoboda (not good). Speaking of not good, Washington State has lost back-to-back games outright as a double-digit favorite. They've went from possible CFB Playoff contenders to after-thoughts. We lean OVER.

**Notre Dame 29 USC 22.** USC is much better than their 6-5 record. Per Josh Pate, six FBS teams have led in every 4th quarter this season. USC is one of them...USC has 5 losses. The other five teams have 5 losses combined! Notre Dame is another one of those teams that has led in the fourth quarter of every game. The Irish are No. 4 in ypp margin, No. 9 in ypg margin and are now No. 1 in scoring margin. They've dominated their opponents since the loss to Northern Illinois. Can they buck history and dominate USC in the Coliseum? They've only won by more than 7 points in their last 27 trips to L.A. We'll take the hook.

**UNLV 36 Nevada 18.** Battle for the Fremont Canon. UNLV is in their largest favorite role in the series since 2000. If the Rebels win, they are heading to Boise for the Mountain West Championship game. Nevada has played well as a big underdog this season with near upsets of SMU and Boise State. Our numbers lean UNLV but we haven't bet side or total.

**NEW MEXICO 33 Hawaii 30.** Keep an eye on the status of Hawaii QB Brayden Schager. He got banged up in the Hawaii's last game vs Utah State. The Warriors are 5-0 ATS at home since a non-cover vs Delaware State in Week Zero. However, New Mexico has been one of the biggest surprises in CFB this season. The Lobos can get to bowl eligibility with a win and their season win total was just 1.5 early in the summer. They have the No. 4 offense in the country and are +0.2 in ypp margin playing a more difficult schedule than Hawaii (-0.5 in ypp).



# Week 14 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 487-414-14 (54.1%) clip!** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

**This year's record is 18-24 so far.** Of the 4 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **UCLA -8.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

# Betting CFB Openers

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is the first book in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). Last year we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Below is some of what we bet already. Starting last season, Fan Duel and Draft Kings have been releasing select CFB games a couple hours before Circa so those bets are included below as well.

**Thursday, November 28th**

**DETROIT 27 Chicago 18.** The Lions are now 10-1 for the first time since 1934. That was their inaugural season in Detroit. This is their biggest favorite role on Thanksgiving since 1968. However, Detroit is 0-3 SU on Thanksgiving under head coach Dan Campbell and they are banged up. Chicago has lost 5 straight games and fell to 5-18 in one possession games under Eberflus after last week’s OT loss to the Vikings. Early money has been on Chicago here, we like the UNDER.

**DALLAS 20 N.Y. Giants 17.** This is one of the worst Dallas games on Thanksgiving in recent memory. Despite last week’s shocking upset of Washington as 10.5-point underdogs, Dallas is just 4-7. The high-scoring final was misleading last week as 31 points were scored in the final 4 minutes, the most in any NFL game in more than a decade. Meanwhile, the Giants have failed to cover 6 straight. There appears to be locker-room issues. We don’t have interest in this game.

**GREEN BAY 27 Miami 23.** Miami is playing their best ball of the season with 4 straight covers. Green Bay has been playing well all season as the Packers try to keep pace with the Lions and Vikings in the great NFC North. GB is 4th in ypp margin and has played the much tougher schedule. The first we looked for was the weather forecast. Kickoff temp is supposed to be 28 degrees. The high in Miami on Thanksgiving is 83 degrees. You know what to do.

**Friday, November 29th**

**KANSAS CITY 28 Las Vegas 17.** For the first time ever, we got a Black Friday NFL game. Not sure it’s the greatest matchup considering we have the 2nd biggest spread of the season. It’s tough laying points with KC right now. Yes, the Chiefs are 10-1 but eight of those wins are by 7 points or less. KC has failed to cover the spread in each of their last 5 games. However, it’s tough backing this Las Vegas team that has so much turmoil in the locker-room and on the field have lost 7 straight. QB Minshew is out for the year and Aidan O’Connell looks like he will get the start. Las Vegas upset the Chiefs last year in Arrowhead. It won’t happen this year.

**Sunday, December 1st**

**WASHINGTON 26 Tennessee 20.** Tennessee was 1-9 ATS on the season until their shocking upset of Houston last week as 8-point underdogs. Meanwhile, Washington is reeling having lost 3 in a row. Tennessee is +0.1 in ypp margin despite playing a much tougher schedule than Washington who is not much better at +0.3. Is this a “Buy Low, Sell High” spot for Washington or is their value in the stats and strength of schedule. We lean OVER.

**ATLANTA 25 L.A. Chargers 24.** Nice spot for Atlanta here coming off a bye catching the Chargers traveling off the big MNF showdown with Baltimore. Atlanta has been the slightly better team in ypp margin (+0.2 vs +0.1) and have played the tougher schedule. We like the Falcons outright but think they are a great teaser option at “+8”.

**CINCINNATI 26 Pittsburgh 23.** Cincinnati comes in off a bye while Pittsburgh also has extra rest having played last Thursday. Cincinnati is better than their 4-7 record as the Bengals are +0.2 in ypp margin while the 8-3 Steelers are -0.2 in ypp margin. Cincinnati has played the tougher schedule too. Had Pittsburgh not just lost to Cleveland, we’d be calling Cincinnati one of our favorite plays of the week.

**Indianapolis 23 NEW ENGLAND 20.** Indy has lost 3 of their last 4 and were easily dispatched by the Lions last week. New England was showing signs of improvement in recent weeks but were blasted by the Dolphins. The Colts are clearly superior and have played the tougher schedule. Neither team has had a bye yet and we wonder if they are running on empty. Not sure we are comfortable laying points on the road with the Colts who lost outright in this role way back in Week 2 vs a Green Bay team playing with a backup QB.

**Houston 24 JACKSONVILLE 20.** Jacksonville comes in off the bye after the worst loss in franchise history (52-6 at Detroit). It’s been a miserable 2-9 season despite having a preseason win total of 8.5. Jacksonville did cover the earlier meeting in a 24-20 loss (+5.5). Meanwhile, Houston has lost 3 of their last 4 including as an 8-point favorite to Tennessee last week. QB CJ Stroud has thrown 9 interception this year already after throwing only 5 last year. We don’t plan to be involved.

**MINNESOTA 25 Arizona 20.** Two surprise teams here. Arizona’s win total was 7 and yet they sit at 6-5 even after a loss to Seattle last week. Meanwhile, the Vikings win total was as low as 6.5 and yet the Vikings are 9-2 straight up. Both teams are similar in the stats at +0.6 in ypp margin but Arizona has played the tougher schedule. QB Murray did get banged up a bit last week. That us leaning with the Vikings for now.

**Seattle 20 N.Y. JETS 19.** Two franchises heading in the opposite direction. The Jets are off a bye but are just 1-7 SU and ATS in their last 8. They have an interim coach, an old QB and terrible leadership at the top of the organization. Meanwhile, the Seahawks have a young staff that has exceeded expectations so far and are off two big wins over San Francisco and Arizona in division play. We’re not wild about the price considering the stats (Seattle 0.0 in ypp margin, NYJ +0.1). We lean UNDER.

**Tampa Bay 26 CAROLINA 22.** Obviously, Carolina has started to show signs of life after a horrific 1-7 SU/ATS start. That’s 3 straight covers now and 2 outright upsets as Bryce Young continues to play well. The Panthers almost got another outright upset last week as a big underdog vs Kansas City. Meanwhile, Tampa has covered 3 in a row and blew out the Giants last week on the road. They’re laying the same number here. However, the vibes around Carolina right now are much better than the Giants. Lean dog.

**L.A. Rams 25 NEW ORLEANS 22.** There’s a big back and forth in the market on this one this week. A lot of it has to do with the polarization of the 5-6 Rams. They have played one of the toughest schedules in the NFL this season but have fell short of expectation at 4-7 ATS. The Saints are off a bye and won and covered their previous two with the interim coach Darren Rizzi. We lean UNDER.

**BALTIMORE 26 Philadelphia 24.** Obviously, the biggest game of the week. Statistically, these are the top two teams. Baltimore is No. 1 in ypp margin at +1.5 while Philadelphia is No. 2 at +1.2. Baltimore has not had a bye yet and are coming off a big game on MNF vs the Chargers. Meanwhile, Philadelphia has won 7 straight games after their early bye. Last week RB Barkley ran for a franchise-record 255 yards in their blowout win over the Rams on SNF. It was the 9th most in any game in NFL history. We’d be interested in Philly here if we got a “+3.5”. Not sure, we’ll see it.

**BUFFALO 25 San Francisco 17.** It’s officially going to be a lost season for the 49ers. They’ve been favored in 10 of their 11 games but now sit at 5-6. Last week with QB Purdy, LT Williams and EDGE Bosa all out, they were crushed by the Packers in their first underdog role of the season. Now they find themselves an even bigger underdog vs a rested Buffalo team. Kickoff temperatures are supposed to be in the high 20’s with possible snow. Not good news for the boys from Cali. We lean UNDER.

**Monday, December 2nd**

**DENVER 25 Cleveland 19.** Memories of the AFC Championship games in the late 1980’s come to mind whenever these two meet. Cleveland has extra rest off their big win over the Steelers in the snow last Thursday. A friendly PSA, with winter weather now upon us...a little bit of snow is actually good for OVERs, not UNDERs as evidence of the 27 points scored in the fourth quarter of Cleveland and Pittsburgh after the field got covered up with snow. Back to this game...Denver has been one of the biggest surprises in the NFL. Their win total was 5.5 and yet the Broncos are 7-5 SU and 9-3 ATS. They have not had a bye yet and would love to add another win prior. Denver is much better in ypp margin as they are +0.4 while Cleveland is dead-last at -1.2. The Browns have shown more fight with Winston at QB but we lean Denver and the OVER.
