Overall Goals and Aims of the Programme

Definition

A Gifted and Talented Student Within Physical Education is...

In BISAK's Physical Education department a 'talented' pupil is one with one or more abilities developed to a level significantly ahead of their year group (or with the potential to develop those abilities).

In order to aid identification and definition of gifted and talented students it is important that we have a clear understanding of the full range of abilities within PE. These abilities can be categorised as follows:




- Physical Ability—Competence and fitness to perform a range of physical activities
- Creative Ability—Innovative responses to a range of challenges, tasks and problems.
- Cognitive Ability—Exceptional planning, compositional skills, reflective performers.
- Personal Ability— Self motivated, ability to work independently and with initiative.
- Social Ability—Leadership qualities, strong communication and teamwork skills
