
Proposed Assisted Living Facility Development

A developer, Burkard Homes, LLC of Arnold, Maryland is proposing to build an 82 unit (94 beds) Assisted Living facility at 900 S. Rolling Rd. (bordering Collegiate Drive). By comparison the Brightview Assisted Living facility next to the Y is 140 units. The proposed structure would be located where the current Magnolia Manor Assisted Living facility is located. This 3.7-acre property is currently zoned DR 2 and the developer will need to get an zoning exception using the PUD process; be supported by Councilman Tom Quirk and be approved by the Baltimore County. Plans call for access to the facility to be from S. Rolling Rd. and would include a 40-car parking lot for staff and visitors. The structure would be three stories high facing Rolling Rd. and four stories high facing Collegiate. See schematic rendering below.
