Roy B. Messer, 77, of Caro passed away Wednesday, Jan. 30, 2002, at Tuscola County Medical Care Facility. He was born on March 3, 1924, in Bertha, Minn. and came to Michigan in 1955, where he took a job with Chrysler Corporation in the space program. On Aug. 13, 1960, he married the former Eleanor Meihofner in Detroit. They lived in New Orleans from 1962 through 1968. Then in St. Louis, Mo. and returning to Michigan, retiring in 1970. After his retirement, he returned to farming and did so in Elmwood Township from 1970 until 1985. While a resident of Elmwood Township, Roy served 10 years as the Elmwood Township Supervisor.
