"Buck" Langley, 69 of Mount Pleasant, formerly of Caseville, died Monday, Nov. 11, at the VA Medical Center, Detroit following a long battle with lung cancer.

He was born Oct. 12, 1927 in Caseville to the late Vern and Mary (Cobb) Langley. Mr. Langley was a member of the Joe Ulsh VFW Post #8215, Shepherd, the D.A.V. and a World War II veteran, serving with the Army Air Corps in the South Pacific.
