1. **pendent lite:** while the litigation is pending
2. **per autre vie:** during the life of another
3. **per stirpes:** by the family; by representation; that method of dividing an estate where a class or group take the share to which their deceased relative would have been entitled
4. **perambulation:** a walking of boundaries
5. **perpetuity:** continuing forever; tying up property for a period beyond the life of a person alive plus 21 years
6. **plebiscite:** a vote of the people on some measure submitted to them
7. **plenipotentiary:** a person invested with full power to transact business; one who has complete authority to do something
8. **praecipe:** command; a note on which the particulars of the process which a person wishes to have issued are written
9. **preterition:** omission of a child's name from a parent's will
10. **pro indiviso:** as undivided; descriptive of the possession of lands before partition
