Public Assembly Health Guidelines for Worship and Activities At the Building

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It has been over two months since we have all met for public worship and our regular church activities at the building. We trust that all is well with you and that you are staying safe. Because of our love, care, and closeness, we have missed one another a great deal. However, it is time for us to begin to gradually start our regular worship and church activities.

The Leadership Team has been in much prayer and discussion and has decided that we will not open completely because like everyone else, we just do not know how this COVID-19 virus is going to continue to play out. As Christians and children of God, we are praying and trusting in God to take care of us as He has done so these past few months and through the years. We believe that He will do His part if we do what we can to stay safe and healthy. With this in mind, we set forth the following guidelines as we begin to have our public services again at the building.

1. These guidelines are in line with the CDC guidelines.
2. Please observe and abide by the various signs posted throughout the building to remind us to stay safe and healthy.
3. The entire building and surfaces have been disinfected. We will clean and sanitize the building and surfaces between each public service.
4. Please arrive wearing face masks and gloves.
5. Please do not shake hands or hug one another; we know this will be difficult (see the attachment). Also, fellowship outside of the building before or after service. Do not stand around inside as we are accustomed to doing.
6. Everyone will enter through one door. We will take everyone's temperature as you enter the building. If your temperature is over 101 degrees, you will be asked to go home and worship online with us.
7. We ask that everyone consistently use the sanitizer stations we have throughout the building.
8. No more than two people at a time in the restrooms.

9. Please pick up around the area where you sat as you leave.
10. The floors and pews in the building have been marked with blue tape indicating 6 feet of distance. Please notice and adhere to them.
11. Because of the 6 feet distance around the building, we can only seat a certain number of people; therefore, we will offer an 8:00 am, 11:00 am, and a 6:00 pm worship service. We need everyone to sign up for which service you would like to attend on the attendance cards by writing 1, 2, 3 next to the time. If there is an overflow of people at any of these services, they will be asked to worship in the Family Life Center using the projector screen. If necessary, we will add a fourth service to accommodate the crowd.
12. Sunday morning Bible School for all ages will not be held at this time.
13. Wednesday evening Bible Study will continue to be offered online at 7:00 pm with Bro. Al Jackson. We will also continue all of the other studies Bro. Jackson conducts online (Marriage, Singles, Young Adults, and Youth).
14. Youth Wednesday Night Bible Study will continue on Zoom but at 6:00 pm instead of 5:30 pm.
15. All of the songbooks and bibles have been removed from the pews.
16. Response cards can be picked up at the front desk when you receive your communion cup.
17. We ask that everyone submits their contributions online. We currently offer PayPal (paypal.me/nscocjaxfl) and Cash App ([cash.app/\\$nscocjaxfl](https://cash.app/$nscocjaxfl)).
18. If you do bring your contribution to the services, please drop them off in the designated stations as you enter the building. The collection plate will not be passed around.
19. If you require money back from your contributions, please see one of the brothers on the Finance Committee.
20. We encourage everyone to sign up to receive the bulletin in email form. To sign up, send a text message to the number 22828, in the body of the text type NSCOC. You will receive a reply text asking you for your email address. Type in your email address and send it. You are now signed up to receive our weekly e-blast which contains the bulletin. Or you may access the bulletin on our website, www.nscocjax.com. If bulletins or newsletters are passed out, it will be done at the end of service as you leave.
21. Keep in mind that we are in this together. Let's remind each other about staying safe and being healthy.
22. One way to stay safe and healthy is to stay at home and worship online if you are ill or are not feeling well.
23. If you are 65 or older, the CDC recommends that you stay at home.
24. If you have respiratory problems, heart, and other conditions, you should also stay at home.
25. We are all in this together, "Beloved, let us love one another!"
