WHAT: Transportation from the Cabin and back; two nights of lodging at Buck Ridge Ski Lodge in West Dover, VT (1.5 miles from Mount Snow Ski Resort); two days on the slopes (Saturday and Sunday) at Mount Snow.

IMPORTANT:

- **ALL ATTENDEES must** bring equipment (meaning: helmet, snowboard or skis and accompanying boots, and poles if skiing) with them on this trip.
- NO RENTALS AT THE MOUNTAIN! See below for information on local rentals.

Cost: "EARLY BIRD SPECIAL" DEAL FOR ATTENDEES!

Amounts below are the discounted "early bird" fee amounts.

TO GET THESE RATES, YOU MUST REMIT FORMS **AND** PAYMENT BY FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 23rd. ADD \$40 IF FORM AND PAYMENT NOT RECEIVED BY FEBRUARY 23rd.

For Scouts (up to and including 18 years old):

- NO CHARGE for Scouts with a "Peak Pass" that is accepted at Mount Snow;
- \$95 for Scouts for two-day lift ticket
- ADD \$125 if a Scout needs a lesson (NOTE we MUST have at least two Scouts for lessons or we will not make a lesson available. Lessons are group lessons and will be offered ONLY on Saturday. Scouts taking lessons will be "buddied up" for the lessons and for the rest of the trip).

For adults who are skiing or boarding (19 and older):

- \$155 with a "Peak Pass" (or for non-skiing adults limited space for non-skiers);
- \$295 for a two-day lift ticket

Cost for reservations received after Friday, February 23rd: Add \$45. No exceptions.

SKI/SNOWBOARD RENTALS:

All attendees who will be on the slopes must bring equipment on the trip. We are not renting equipment in VT. If you do not already have equipment, you will need to rent locally (that is, in the Chester Count area). See attached list of some locations. CALL your local provider and reserve your equipment for the ski trip NOW. Most providers will have a two-day rental program. You should be able to pick up equipment on Friday before the trip and then bring it with you – but RESERVE AHEAD! Visit your local ski shop NOW and get your sizing done early, then do a two-day rental.

ALL SKIING/BOARDING PARTICIPANTS MUST USE A HELMET – NO EXCEPTIONS.

NO RESERVATIONS ACCEPTED AFTER MARCH 1st. SPACE LIMITED: RESERVE YOUR SPACE NOW!

Note: The Troop will provide a snack for the hill on Saturday and a packed lunch on Sunday for the trip home. Attendees who are skiing/boarding are responsible for their own lunch at the mountain on Saturday. Please bring money for Saturday lunch!

Departure: Arrive at the cabin no later than 5:30 PM, Friday March 8.

Return: 7:30 PM Sunday March 10, Cabin (boys will call when 30 minutes from cabin)

Transport: Bus for Scouts and leaders/accompanying fathers and leaders

How to sign up for the Vermont ski trip:

 Either bring your payment and completed form to the February 23rd meeting, or MAIL your completed form and payment to Jim Bennett (see address below) or drop your completed form and payment at his house so that Mr. Bennett receives it by *no later than* February 23rd.

Put your name on each piece of your rental equipment with "78" after it (so, Scout Fred Smith would write "Smith – 78" on a piece of masking tape and affix it to each ski or board, each boot, each pole and your helmet). **Skis and poles MUST be rubber-banded together.** You will hand your skis or board to those packing the bus. Keep your boots and helmet with your personal gear.

BOOTS AND HELMETS GO ON AT THE LODGE AND ARE WORN OVER TO THE RIDE TO THE HILL.

Please be on-time for our departure. Bus leaves the Cabin at 6 PM on Friday evening, March 8th. Get there early. Please follow these directions. Looking forward to a great time!
