# This Sunday's Counsel

#### THEME:

We journey to a life of perfect love, unity and peace when we obey God and keep His covenant.

#### WORD:

Our triune God leads us to a faith journey of perfect love, unity and peace.

"..serve the Lord with gladness...." (Ps 100:1)

Joyfully accept assignments given to you.

"Therefore, if you hearken to my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my special posses-

sion, dearer to me than all other people, though all the earth is mine. You shall be to me a kingdom of priests, a holy nation. " (Exodus 19:5-6)

What a great promise our Lord has made and if we listen, we will be His special possession, a holy nation.

Christ died for us while we were still sinners. He showed His immense love for us, through the psalm, the second reading and the gospel.

But what did we do in return? This goes with the premise that we would have a better chance of convincing them, because they see us and witness how we live our life, patterned from Christ's teaching, and living a life of perfect love, peace, and unity. This we can only get from obeying God's law and keeping His covenant. Jesus gave instructions to his twelve apostles, to prepare them for the mission he left with them. He asked them to proclaim that the kingdom of heaven is at hand, to cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, drive out demons. To be selfless, to give the best of themselves without counting the cost of giving. Many times, in our walk with Christ, we encounter many obstacles, challenges and sometimes failures which are all beyond our control. We oftentimes try to solve them relying on our human strength, and wisdom or power.

We forget that if we live godly in Almighty Father, we must first experience sufferings, tribulations and persecutions, then try to overcome them with patience, love, tolerance and understanding.

#### SHARED PERSONAL REFLECTIONS OF THE LSS CLASS 17 GRADUATES

- 1 The Life in the Spirit Seminar was God's way of granting my desire to deepen my Faith in Him. Through the LSS, I was able to understand more about the Holy Spirit. My mom would tell me to pray to the Holy Spirit. I do, but I do not fully comprehend the significance because I do pray to God as well. The retreat enlightened my understanding about the Holy Spirit.
