Straight aviation snip or any metal-cutting snips

Carpenters tool and nail pouch with belt &/or suspenders
Stair gauges (optional)
Combination square and/or speed square

Drill Bit Set for Cordless Drill to Include a minimum of: one apex (bit holder), #1, #2, #3 and drywall Phillips bits, #2 square drive bit, T15, T20 and T25 Torx bits, 1/16" through 1/2" drill bits, 5/8" and 3/4" paddle bits,

Equipment carried in a carpenter's toolbox, tool bucket or other appropriate container
