

Brush & Limb Disposal

The City of Shiner will no longer do monthly brush pickup. City of Shiner residents who wish to dispose of their brush & limb waste may choose to use the City's designated disposal site free of charge. The collection site is located at Green-Dickson Park and is open from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm on the first, third, and fifth Saturday of each month and each Monday and Wednesday from 8:00am to 11:30am (weather permitting and excluding holidays). Residents will need to show proof of their City of Shiner address by providing a utility bill and must show a picture identification to confirm their identity. This disposal site is for residential brush & limbs only.

Over 65 or Disabled

For those 65 or older or who are disabled to have their residential brush & limbs picked up. Pick up days will be the first and third Friday of every month. Evidence of eligibility for the exemption is required. This is accomplished by registering your name and address with City Hall. Tree limbs less than 6 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter will be picked up at no charge. Brush & limbs that fall outside the prescribed standards must be removed no later than seven (7) days from attempted pickup date. Family members that trim or remove trees are responsible for disposal. If you have any questions regarding the waiver, please contact the City of Shiner City Hall at (361) 594-3362.
