The Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary is a Holy Day of Obligation which means it is an important feast day so be sure to attend Mass on **Monday August 15** @ 9:00 AM or 6:00 PM

Did you know...?

On the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we remember when Mary was taken or "assumed" into heaven, body and soul, after she died. You will not find this story in the Bible. However, a tradition handed down from the earliest days of the Church says that Mary died in Jerusalem and was buried in a tomb. But when the apostles opened the tomb again, her body was gone. Why would God take Mary's body and soul into heaven? In part because Mary is special to God: she said "yes" to becoming the mother of Jesus. But God also wanted to show us that one day, all of us will share in the bodily resurrection of Jesus. Mary is the first person in the Church to experience the resurrection in its fullness.
