Outpatient Program

ACTS outpatient program offers assessment, treatment, supportive services, urine collection for drug testing and referral services to substance Dependent individuals and those with co-occurring substance abuse and mental health disorders.

Admissions and Referrals

Outpatient serves substance involved individuals who need this level of care to learn and incorporate recovery skills and relapse prevention tools.

Direct Referrals

Direct referrals are accepted from selfreferrals, physicians, law enforcement, court officials, Department of Corrections, Department of Juvenile Justice, Salvation Army and other community agencies.

Walk-In Hours

Assessments are available on a walkin basis on Monday - Thursday from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m., and 9 a.m. - 2 p.m. on Friday.

Appointments are also available for assessments.



Individual Responsibilities

Provide necessary admission items and participation as follows:

- Picture ID
- Healthcare/Insurance Information
- Income Information
- Prescribed medication lists (if applicable)
- Participation in ongoing assessment processes
- Participation in group and individual curriculum
- Participation in urine drug screening

Discharge Planning

Plans for continuing care begin at the time of admission. Prior to discharge, recommendations are made in conference with the person served based on individual needs and treatment preferences.

At the time of discharge, the person served is asked to participate in an anonymous consumer feedback survey in order to provide informational feedback regarding the services that were provided during their episode of care. This information is carefully reviewed and if necessary changes are implemented by the agency's Quality Improvement department.

Financial Information

ACTS is a private, non-profit organization. Fees for services are due when services are rendered. Reductions and/or waivers are established on a sliding scale basis. ACTS will be collecting \$65 for all initial assessments completed, which is not subject to the sliding fee scale and is due upon intake. We do not refuse services to anyone based on their inability to pay.
