THEME:

Our faith in Jesus Christ remains strong when we take courage and put our full trust in Him.

WORD:

Our heavenly Father is pleased with those who have strong faith in Jesus.

PROMISE:

"The Lord himself...shall walk before him, and prepare the way of his steps." (Ps 85: 13a,14)

ORDER:

"..speak the truth in Christ" (Rom 9:1)

DIRECTION:

Be bold in spreading the Word of God.

In the gospel, Jesus uses the opportunity in the storm to strengthen the faith of His disciples. He is away praying in the mountain when the storm starts tossing them in the sea. He comes to their rescue, although they fail to recognize Him at first. He responds to their inability to see Him with the

statement "Take courage, it is I, do not be afraid." But still, they need proof. Peter said "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water."

Christ foresaw the storm and the grave risk His apostles would run.



But that trial and the grave danger they ran was for their own good because they learn to realize that He was from God, and they could always trust Him. God have foreseen our trials and earthly ailments, but He permitted them so that we will draw closer to Him and help us on the road to

heaven.

REFLECTION NO. 3

After attending the Life in the Spirit Seminar, I became the "NEW" me. The rude and constant complainer at work changed to a NEW creation of GOD.

I was like a seed planted into the good soil which is the BLD community. Slowly but surely, I am growing to be like Jesus. Even my colleagues noticed the change and said that my soul is shining, and the fruits of the Holy Spirit empower me.

At first, I was hesitant to sign up to be a committed member because it takes so much of my time, and I do not want added responsibility for the reason I may not be capable of doing the tasks.

Attending teachings, Praise and Worship activities and discipleship sessions helped and molded me to become a good disciple of GOD.

REFLECTION NO. 4
