### Original:

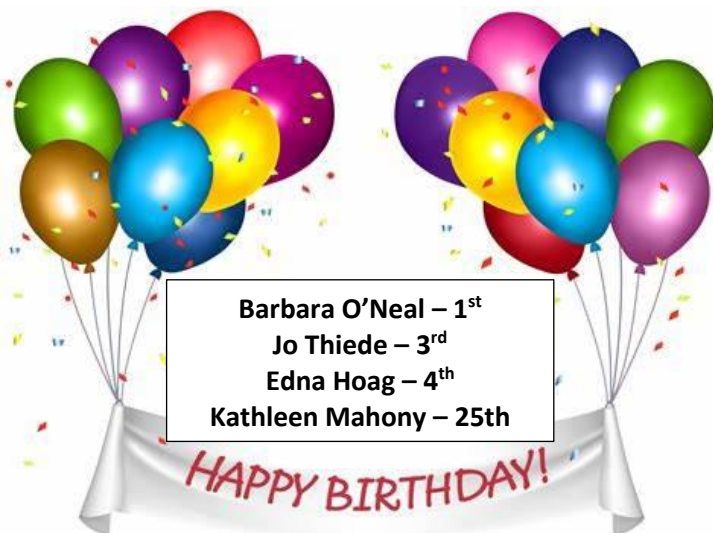
"Whan that Aprill, with his shoures soote
