Dave Christenson Shoots Perfect Score

Southport Members at the Small bore National Championships

Southport rifle team members David Christenson and Jon Speck competed in the Smallbore Conventional Prone National Championship, a grueling 4 day match with 4800 possible points. Dave scored 4766-288x and Jon scored 4675-193x. Dave won 1st Expert in the following 2 matches: Any Sight Dewar Day 1 and Any Sight 100 Yard Day 1. Dave won 2nd Expert in the following 2 matches: Any Sight 50 Meter Day 2 and Any Sight 100 Yard Day 2. Dave also was the highest scoring Expert in the following 2 matches: Any Sight Day 2 Aggregate and Any Sight Aggregate (both days). Dave even beat Olympic shooter Michael McPhail in one match with a perfect 400!

Southport Members at the Wisconsin State Outdoor Smallbore Championship

Southport rifle team members **David Christenson, Jon Speck**, and **Clark Curtis**competed in the Wisconsin Smallbore Outdoor 3-Position State Championship on August 12, with 1200 possible points. Match winner was Paula Lambertz, from Illinois, with 1092 points. Wisconsin champion was Wayne Parrell with 1089 points. **Dave** was the second highest Wisconsin shooter with 1075 points. **Jon** scored 955 points, and **Clark** scored 862.

Air Pistol League

With the success of last years .177 cal. air pistol league, Bill Means has agreed to facilitate it again for the 2017-18 indoor season. Running during the entire Fall/Winter indoor season, members may sign up at the club. In addition to being a great way to improve your own scores, this is a great opportunity to get younger shooters started in competitive pistol sports.

The course of fire will be 5 shots at each of two NRA B-40, "10 Meter Air Pistol Target" every 2 weeks. Iron sights only! Targets are to be turned in on the 1st and 15th of each month beginning September 15th, self-scored with shooters name.

This league may be shot at the club or at home. At the range, targets are posted at 10 meters distance. Target holders are hung from the ceiling and the bullet trap plywood panels are opened to prevent pellets from bouncing back. At home, a simple 22 caliber steel trap, or a cardboard box filled with newspapers is appropriate. Most basements will provide a 10 meter (33 foot) distance to comply.

The fee will be \$5.00 to cover the cost of targets and awards.

A Daisy Model 777 single shot pump air pistol was standard competitive equipment in years past. Avanti is still offering the Model 714 and 747 which are similar. The Gamo Compact Target looks promising and if you're on a budget, the Beeman Model P17 should get you started. Similar air pistols can be found on the internet both used and new. 
So, if you've been skipping the leagues because of the recent shortage of ammo, please consider getting back to the range and support your local gun club!

1st NOTICE 2018 TO ALL SOUTHPORT MEMBERS: NRA Membership is Required to Maintain Southport Membership

According to the club's bylaws, all members must also be NRA members. All new members must provide their NRA number prior to acceptance into the club. To maintain our status as an NRA Gold Medal Club, we must also insure that club mem-bers remain NRA members; therefore, except for NRA Life Members, we must all validate NRA membership in January of each year.

Methods of Compliance:

Submit or photo copy the mailing label from your current NRA Magazine. Mail it to Stephen Close, 639 Ivy Court, Kenilworth, IL 60043, or e-mail to stephen.close@sbcglobal.net or bring it to the January club meeting.

The electronic access key for any member who does not comply by the end of February with be disabled. Subsequently, after validation, keys will be turned back on at the next regular meeting. Dues will not be recoverable for the time an individual key is shut down.

CCW Training Policy Reminders

A number of members are providing firearms safety classes for concealed carry weapons training. Any member providing training for personal monetary gain must carry the NRA \$1M liability insurance with Southport Gun Club, Inc., named as also insured.

Please remember:

- CCW programs may not interfere with member access to the range.
 Note: NRA courses do have priority over member access.
- All participants must sign the Release and Indemnification form.
- A \$10.00 maintenance donation is asked for live fire exercises.
- Guns to be introduced to the shooting line must be brought in unloaded and in a case. Muzzles must remain pointed down-range at all times.
- Use of ECU's (empty chamber indicators) is required.
- All shooting on this range must be done from behind the yellow line.
 Note: an adjustable-height target holder may be placed between the yellow line and the bullet trap. To minimize damage to the plywood back plash panels, please use lanes #1 and #10 for CCW exercises.
- No "quick draw," "shooting from the hip" or "spray and pray."
- No human images or human-like silhouette targets may be posted.
- More than 5 shooters requires additional range safety officers.
- All other range restrictions and maintenance activities apply.

Mid-range Target Placement for Safety

Because the ballistic steel in the bullet trap is comprised of 10 separate plates, there are gaps between them. The top of these plates are located about 10 inches below the top of the trap, thus creating another sharp edge. To protect the trap and minimize bullet splatter, it is imperative that all shots are carefully aimed at a target that is placed on the target holders. TO AVOID INJURY FROM BULLET SPLATTER, ALL SHOOTING MUST BE DONE FROM BEHIND THE YELLOW LINE!

If a mid-range target holder is used, it must be positioned so that the target is located directly between the individual shooters eye and the center of a ballistic steel plate. As shown in the photo at the right, the target must be posted exactly centered under one of the lane numbers that are just above the trap. It must also be located at the same visual height (or lower) than the target holders either side of the adjacent lanes.
