DESCRIPTION: Here is a Bob Lee (Wing) designed Colt Plainsman. Wing had the initial contract to produce Colt branded bows as Colt did not produce any of their own bows. Colt bows with Hartford CT under the logo were made by Wing (later the Colt contract went to Ben Pearson). This bow has a few nicks and blemishes in the Cherry riser (see pics). Were I to keep it as my regular daily shooter, I would probably refinish the riser. However, the bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in excellent condition. Overall, this is a nice bow for its age.
