This 27'RV travel trailer was generously donated by Mike & Cindy Poland of Greenwood, Indiana. Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Inc. non-profit will convert it into a 'Veterans Mobile Video Studio'. Once the trailer is deemed road worthy, it will have American flag graphics applied to it. The studio will be fitted with state-of-the-art equipment to record and produce professional quality oral history videos of Veterans. We will be using green screen technology and will be able to offer different backgrounds and service branch logos. The new equipment can record and burn a DVD of the footage FREE for the Veteran to take with them as a keepsake for their family. We will then use the footage to be included in the Indiana Vietnam 50th Commemorative Gift, our endorsed Indiana Bicentennial Legacy Project which will be permanently archived in the Library of Congress. We will be installing video screens and speakers on the exterior of the studio for listening and watching the legacy stories unfold. Volunteers will be travelling to events in all 92 Indiana counties, the State Fair and large events and make this service available to Hoosier Veterans and their families.

We need \$15,000 to complete this project by August 15, 2015.
