

ORDINANCE NO. 2007 - 6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE TO SECURE TOWN HALL AFTER FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Town Council to secure the Town Hall within a reasonable time following the end of Town Council meetings and other functions that take place in the council chambers:

WHEREAS, the orderly and reasonably prompt departure of members of town government and members of the public following meetings in the Town Hall helps maintain order.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE,

I. Members of the public attending Town Council meetings or other authorized functions in the town council chambers shall be asked to exit the chambers reasonably promptly following the end of those meetings.

Reasonably promptly means as soon as practical without rushing, but in any event the chambers shall be vacated not later than fifteen minutes following the end of the meetings.

Violation of this ordinance may be fined, not to exceed \$2,500 for a first violation and up to \$7,500 for second and subsequent violations.

This ordinance is hereby passed and adopted at the meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana this 14th day of August, 2007.
