

Death Takes Jay Andrews

Funeral services were held at 2 p. m. Sunday, June 18, in the Canboro Latter Day Saints Church for Jay Andrews, 63, who died at his farm home Friday following several years of poor health.

Mr. Andrews was born in Rochester, Michigan, August 8, 1886 and moved with his parents to Grant Township in 1895, where he was a member of the Masons and at one time a member of the Owendale board of education.
