

Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada

August 25-29, 2019

5 Days, 4 Nights

Sunday ♦ Travel Day

Today we'll journey north to cross the Rainbow Bridge into Ontario, Canada. **A valid passport or passport card is required for this tour.** After we check into the Travelodge Hotel by the Falls, enjoy the evening on your own for dinner in the Clifton Hill area not far from the falls.

Monday ♦ Niagara Falls

After an included breakfast, we'll depart for a full day of Niagara Falls touring. Our local guide will introduce us to the sights and sounds of the Canadian side of Niagara Falls. We will see Table Rock, Queen Victoria Park and the Floral Clock. We will take a journey behind the falls. Wearing a rain poncho, we'll take an elevator 150 feet down the cliff to two outdoor decks located directly behind the falls. Over 2,800 cubic meters of water thunders over the brink every second!

Next we take a walk like no other, along a boardwalk at the very edge of one of the world's wildest stretches of whitewater! Marvel at the relentless power and beauty of nature, and see how the deep and narrow Great Gorge was created. Trillions of gallons of water are forced into this accelerating trough--the sight will take your breath away!

This evening we are in for a treat at the "Oh Canada Eh" dinner show. The food is great and the service and entertainment never disappoints. You will laugh, sing and maybe dance a bit. On our way back to the hotel, we'll drive by the falls for the evening illumination. (B, D)

Tuesday ♦ Niagara-on-the-Lake

After breakfast, we'll visit the Welland Canal and St. Catharine's Museum. The canal connects Lake Ontario with Lake Erie and allows barges to avoid Niagara Falls. If we're lucky, we'll be able to watch from the observation deck as a ship travels through Lock #3, one of the world's engineering marvels. The museum contains the Ontario

Lacrosse Hall of Fame and showcases one of Canada's most popular sports.

We'll continue our guided touring to Niagara-on-the-Lake, a Canadian town located where the Niagara River meets Lake Ontario. It is often called the loveliest town in Ontario and has a long and distinguished history. The Old Town is made for walking and the countryside spreads out below the Escarpment and is dotted with vineyards. A short walk from the main street takes you to the shore of Lake Ontario. There will be free time to explore the town and have lunch. We'll visit an area winery for a tour, tasting and purchasing of delicious Canadian wines. Late afternoon and evening is on own to enjoy activities of your choice and dinner on own. (B)

Wednesday ♦ Niagara Falls

After breakfast we continue our touring of the falls area with a choice of flying across the Niagara River over the whirlpool in a Spanish Aero Cable Car or walk among over 2000 butterflies at the Butterfly Conservatory in the Botanical Gardens.

This afternoon get an incredible up close experience of the falls on the Hornblower Falls Cruise. You will feel the mist on your face and get amazing views of the falls.

Tonight we have a special "dinner with an incredible view" in the Skylon Tower's revolving dining room. The Skylon Tower offers spectacular views of the Falls, the Great Gorge, Niagara wine district and the city skylines of Buffalo, New York and Toronto. (B, D)
