Sonora Sunrise Rotary Community Garden Guidelines

Welcome to Sonora Sunrise Rotary Community Garden. The following guidelines have been established for members of this garden. Please read them carefully. Your signature is your commitment to the garden and its role in the community.

1. Garden meetings and work parties may be scheduled throughout the season. Please plan to attend to get to know your fellow gardeners and help with garden upkeep.
2. Please keep your box and adjoining pathways tended. Pick up litter when you see it. If your box appears to be untended for a period of time, you will be contacted and your box may be assigned to another gardener. Call the garden leader if you need help or if you plan to be out of town for an extended period. If you plan to discontinue use of your box, please notify the garden leader as soon as possible.
3. Plant tall plants and vines where they will not interfere with your neighbor's box. Planting illegal plants is prohibited.
4. At the end of each growing season, all dead plants and non-plant materials should be removed and disposed of properly. Leave your garden neat and tidy!
5. Please put weeds and dead plant materials in the designated area. Any diseased plants or invasive weeds should be bagged and placed in the trash.
6. Do not apply anything or pick anything from another person's box without their expressed approval.
7. Please do not leave the water unattended. If you see a problem with the water system, please contact the garden leader immediately.
8. Pets, drugs(including alcohol), smoking, chewing tobacco and fires are not allowed.
9. Please supervise children in the garden.
10. The Sonora Sunrise Rotary Community Garden/Doj Park is subject to all local, State and Federal laws. Report theft, vandalism and unusual activities to the garden leader and the police.
11. Gardeners and their associates agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Sonora Sunrise Rotary and Tuolumne County from any negligent or intentional acts that cause harm to people or property at Sonora Sunrise Rotary Community Park.
12. Use common courtesy, be considerate of your fellow gardeners and community neighbors and ENJOY!
- 13. Violation of Gardener Guidelines: If any of the Guidelines are violated, you will be contacted by phone or email and have one week to address the violation. After one week, if the violation has not been remedied, you may lose your gardening privileges.**
