HUNTING TIPS

When you're preparing for your hunting trip, keep in mind that the bowhunter is always at a disadvantage to his prey. Anything you can find to help your chances is all to the good. This means the best equipment and whatever accessories you can take - camouflage, string silencers, brush buttons, buck scent, game calls. It also means practice. The beginning archer, who has probably stayed close to the target to develop his shooting skills, shouldn't make the mistake of thinking that's all he needs. Shoot at various distances before you go, to get the feel of the real situation.

To find the best places for game, talk to residents in the area or do your own looking for tracks and other signs of animals. From then on, your most profitable virtue will be patience. Whether you stalk or shoot from a stand, your success will depend largely on patience. Most game is shot from a stand, or by blind hunting. This requires that you make no movement and no sound, that you be downwind, that you always be alert, and that you wait as long as you need to. If you prefer still hunting, or stalking, move only a short distance at a time, then stop and check carefully for game.

When you spot your prey, draw as quickly but quietly as you can. The best aim is low and directly behind the shoulder. Remember that the animal will die by hemorrhaging, so it is advisable to leave it for a while after the arrow hits.

SHOOTING TIPS

A most important aspect of good shooting is the equipment. It is essential first that your bow be the proper weight. (In archery, "weight" refers to the amount of effort required to draw a bow 28".) You can't control a too-heavy bow, and the effort will wear you out. For most men, the most popular weight for a hunting bow is 40-50 lb. Target shooting, since it involves many more shots in a short space of time, requires a lighter bow, 35-40 lb. Women and juniors usually need a bow about 10 lb. lighter than men, and youngsters take still lighter models.

Length is important too. The longest bows work best for target and field shooters, who require more stability. The short models are better suited to bowhunters, who need compactness for shooting from brush and trees and for convenience in packing. Some hunters, though, prefer somewhat longer bows for their added stability and accuracy.

Having the right arrow is another major factor in good shooting. Your arrow must have the correct amount of stiffness ("spine") for the bow you are using, so that it will bend just enough to pass the bow without going off track.

To string the bow, it is best to use a bow stringer. This will eliminate the risk of injury and the chance of twisting the bow limbs.

Once you're ready to shoot, you might find - whether you're a beginner or an experienced archer — that you're bothered by some common problems.

Many new archers are unable to keep the arrow on the arrow rest. If this happens to you, you probably don't have your fingers hooked around the string. As you draw, you would tend to tighten your fingers — and roll the arrow off the rest. To avoid this, keep the back of your hand straight and hook your fingers well around the string. Then when you draw, your fingers will not roll the arrow off the rest.

A second common problem for beginners is hitting the inside of the bow arm with the bowstring. There's no way to keep the string from ticking your arm as it rebounds. It happens even when you shoot properly. But you can keep that tick from hurting by wearing an arm guard. This is essential equipment for anyone who shoots a bow-from world champion to first-timer. If you consistently get hit behind the arm guard, try rolling your elbow out when

If your arrow appears to fly erratically, it could be due to improper nocking. Be sure the arrow is nocked 1/8" above a line perpendicular to the string.

Forgetting to anchor is another common fault for novice archers. You should think of the anchor — a spot on your face to which you draw every time for the sake of consistency — as comparable to the rear sight on a rifle. Even if you shoot instinctively, you need to use that anchor point. Make sure it is a place you can feel and can come to easily every time you draw. The instinctive shooter's anchor should be directly under the eye. The archer who uses a bow sight needn't have his anchor right there, but he too must be sure to use one place consistently as anchor.

A more experienced archer can have trouble with his anchor too. If you shoot instinctively and you seem to be shooting low, check your anchor to see that it hasn't become too high. If you shoot consistently high, your anchor may be too low. If your are shooting to the left (assuming you are right-handed), you might be anchoring too loosely — too far to the right. Or if your shots seem to go to the right too often, see if you are anchoring too much to the inside.

The same conditions could have other causes, though. Shooting to the right (for a right-hander) could result from "collapsing"— the arms and shoulders drooping inward at the moment of release. If your arrow tends to go to the left, it could be that you are "exploding" when you release. To eliminate this problem, make sure you maintain the exact amount of drawing tension throughout release.

If none of those factors account for your misdirection, check the spine of your arrows. A too-stiff arrow will generally shoot outside the line of the bow (to the right of a righthanded shooter). A too-weak arrow will go to the inside.


BOW GUARANTEE

Every Wing Bow is numbered and accompanied by a registration card which must be filled out and mailed within 10 days after date of purchase. Should failure occur in a bow so registered, the Wing Archery Company will repair, or replace it if repair is not feasible, with the same model or the closest model available. If failure should occur within 6 months of the purchase date, replacement will be made at no charge unless models have changed or list prices have increased, in which case the customer will be charged for the difference in models or difference in list price. The bow must show no evidence of misuse or improper handling, and the serial number must be intact. After 6 months and up to 3 years, and provided



the bow has not been misused or mishandled, repair or replacement will be made for 50% of the list price at time of purchase unless models have changed or list prices have increased, in which case the customer will be charged for the difference in models or difference in list price. No adjustment will be made until the damaged bow is returned to the factory for inspection. Replacement will be made with a bow of the same model and weight, as near as possible. This guarantee is valid only when purchase has been made through an authorized Wing dealer. Dealers are not authorized to make adjustment, but will be glad to handle shipping and correspondence.
