throughout the church and from the large dispensary container in the back of the church.



ST. BARNEY SOLANUS CASEY Feast Day July 30

St. Barney Solanus Casey became one of Detroit's best-known priests even though he was not allowed to preach formally or to hear confessions as his knowledge of theology was judged to be weak. Yet, it brought forth in him a greatness and

a holiness that might never have been realized in any other way. His spiritual fire deeply impressed his listeners. He was noted for conducting well-attended services for the sick where many considered him instrumental in cures and other blessings they received. He led no crusades rather his was a life of simple service in common jobs and love for ordinary people. When he was not himself sick, he suffered with and for those that were sick. When he was not physically hungry, he hungered with people who were He had a divine love for all people. He loved people for what he could do for them-and God, through them. He came to know Christ's truth that pure love of God and one's fellowmen as children of God are in the final event all that matters.

- There will be no distribution of scapulars




VIRTUS ONLINE In keeping with the Archdiocese's desire to provide a safe environment

for all members of the church in Western Washington especially for minors and vulnerable adults all parish employees and volunteers in service to the church must participate in the VIRTUS Safe Environment Training Program in addition to having a background check if you fall into any of the following categories:

- Any volunteer with access to minors or vulnerable adults in their volunteer capacity are required to have a background check every three years, a training class every three years, and to have read and signed the Safe Environment policies at least once.
- Any volunteer with access to money (cash, checks, or other negotiables) is required to have a background check every three years.
- Any volunteer who drives on behalf of the parish is required to have a background check every three years.

VirtusOnline - www.virtusonline.org - is the site which you can log on to and see the status of your existing background check. Every three years a new one needs to be run and the system will send you an email to begin that process if necessary. If you do not have an email address, a manual form can be signed to get the process completed. Please contact Susie Gomez, Virtus Administrator at 360-385-3700 if you have questions.
