What is Domestic Violence?

It is the violent or aggressive behavior within the home, typically involving the violent abuse of a spouse or partner. Every 9 seconds a woman is beaten in the United States. Domestic violence is the leading cause of injury to women—more than car accidents, muggings, and rapes combined. Everyday in the US, more than three women are murdered by their husbands or boyfriends. Based on reports from 10 countries, between 55 percent and 95 percent of women who had been physically abused by their partners had never contacted non-governmental organizations, shelters, or the police for help.
